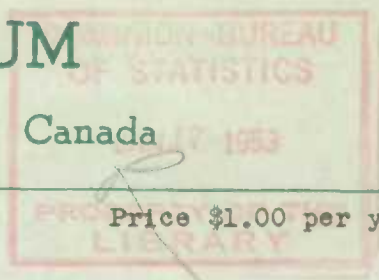

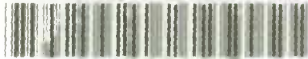
Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 35,586 tons in November, 1952 and 36,871 tons for the month of November, 1951.
