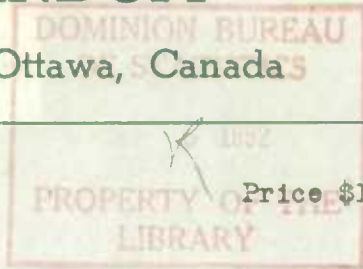

JULY - 1952

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 42,721 tons in July compared with 49,650 tons in the previous month. The July, 1951 shipments totalled 50,929 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 37,585 tons in July, 1952 and 37,754 tons for the month of July, 1951.
