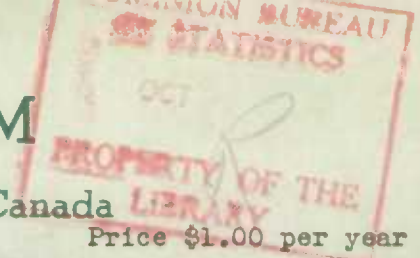

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 43,943 tons in August compared with 42,721 tons in the previous month. The August, 1951 shipments totalled 46,260 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 38,713 tons in August, 1952 and 37,616 tons for the month of August, 1951.
