### SEPTEMBER - 1952

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 45,067 tons in September, compared with 43,943 tons in the previous month. The September, 1951 shipments totalled 44,209 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 35,662 tons in September, 1952 and 36,176 tons for the month of September, 1951.

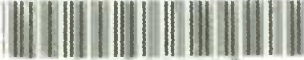
