Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 43,037 tons in January compared with 36,306 tons in the previous month. The January, 1952, shipments totalled 43,928 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 37,088 tons in January, 1953, and 39,148 tons for the month of January, 1952.
