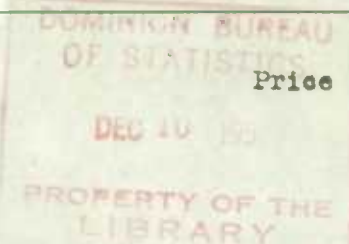

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 45,046 tons in October, 1953, compared with 45,960 tons in the previous month. The October, 1952, shipments totalled 59,388 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 38,048 tons in October, 1953, and 39,701 tons for the month of October, 1952.
