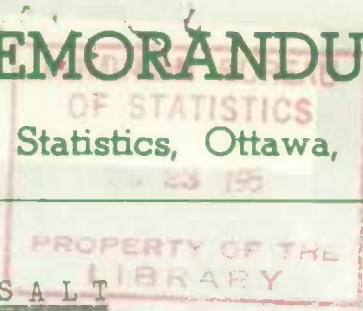

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 38,580 tons in July, compared with 41,369 tons in the previous month. The July, 1952, shipments totalled 42,721 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 37,445 tons in July, 1953, and 37,585 tons for the month of July, 1952.

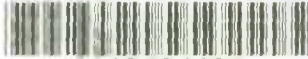
