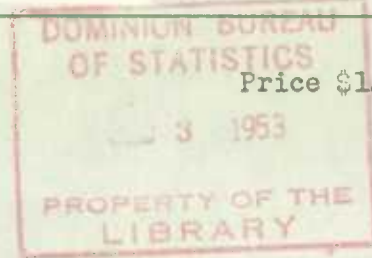

September 1953

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 45,960 tons in September, compared with 44,858 tons in the previous month. The September, 1952, shipments totalled 45,067 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 39,517 tons in September, 1953, and 35,662 tons for the month of September, 1952.
