## SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 50,820 tons in November, 1954, compared with 49,787 tons in the previous month. The November, 1953, shipments totalled 43,844 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,796 tons in November, 1954, and 39,114 tons for the month of November, 1953.
