Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 45,758 tons in August, 1954, compared with 41,730 tons in the previous month. The August, 1953, shipments totalled 44,858 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 34,522 tons in August, 1954, and 37,660 tons for the month of August, 1953.
