Selected Municipalities and Census Metropolitan Areas

The 1966 and 1967 statistics shown in this bulletin represent a selection of data which will be published later, with any necessary revisions, in the respective issues of the DBS publication "Manufacturing Industries of Canada, Section G, Geographical Distribution" (Catalogue No. 31-209).

Table 1 consists of 225 municipalities which, regardless of legal status of incorporation, had 1967 value of shipments of goods of own manufacture of \$10,000,000 and over, and which are publishable under the provisions of the Statistics Act. The basis of municipality selection represents a departure from previous issues of the bulletin, when a similar table contained only publishable incorporated cities regardless of value of shipments. As a result, incorporated cities with shipments of less than \$10,000,000 have been excluded from this bulletin whereas publishable towns, villages and rural municipalities, such as townships with shipments of \$10,000,000 or more have been included.

For comprehensive statistics on the geographic distribution of the manufacturing industries of Canada, please see the latest issue of the above publication (Catalogue No. 31-209) which includes more detailed data than those published in this bulletin.

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Quelques municipalités et zones métropolitaines de recensement

Les statistiques de 1966 et de 1967 publiées dans le présent bulletin sont tirées de celles qui paraîtront, avec d'éventuelles révisions à une date ultérieure dans les éditions de 1966 et de 1967 de la publication du B.F.S. intitulée "Industries manufacturières du Canada, Section G, Répartition géographique" (n° de catalogue 31-209).

Le Tableau 1 présente 225 municipalités qui, nonobstant leur statut juridique, ont enregistré en 1967 la valeur des expéditions de marchandises de propre fabrication d'une valeur de 10 millions de dollars ou plus et qui sont publiables, conformément aux exigences de la Loi sur la statistique. Le choix de la municipalité comme critère marque un changement par rapport aux précédentes éditions de ce bulletin où un tableau similaire présentait les données publiables relatives aux cités constituées et cela, sans tenir compte de la valeur des expéditions. Par conséquent, les cités constituées qui ont enregistré des expéditions d'une valeur inférieure à 10 millions de dollars ont été exclues du présent bulletin, tandis que les données publiables relatives aux villes, villages et municipalités rurales, comme les cantons qui ont signalé des expéditions de 10 millions de dollars et plus y apparaissent.

Le lecteur qui veut des statistiques complètes et détaillées sur la répartition géographique des industries manufacturières, peut consulter la dernière édition de la publication susmentionnée (n° de catalogue 31-209), qui contient des données plus détaillées que celles qui sont présentées dans le présent bulletin.
