INDUSTRIAL STATISTICS OF THE MARITIME PROVINCES, 1919.

Ottawa, December 1921.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics has completed a preliminary survey of the manufacturing industries of the Maritime provinces. Principal statistics, including the number of operating establishments, the amount of capital invested, employees, salaries and wages, cost of materials and value of production are shown comparatively in a series of tables for the calendar years 1917, 1918 and 1919. The first of these tables shows statistics for the Maritime provinces as a whole; the second, the statistics for each of the individual provinces comprising the Maritime division; the third, similar statistics for the cities and towns in each province having a population of 5,000 and over, compared for calendar year 1917, 1918 and 1919; while the fourth table shows the statistics for each of the ten leading industries within the provinces for the calendar year 1919.

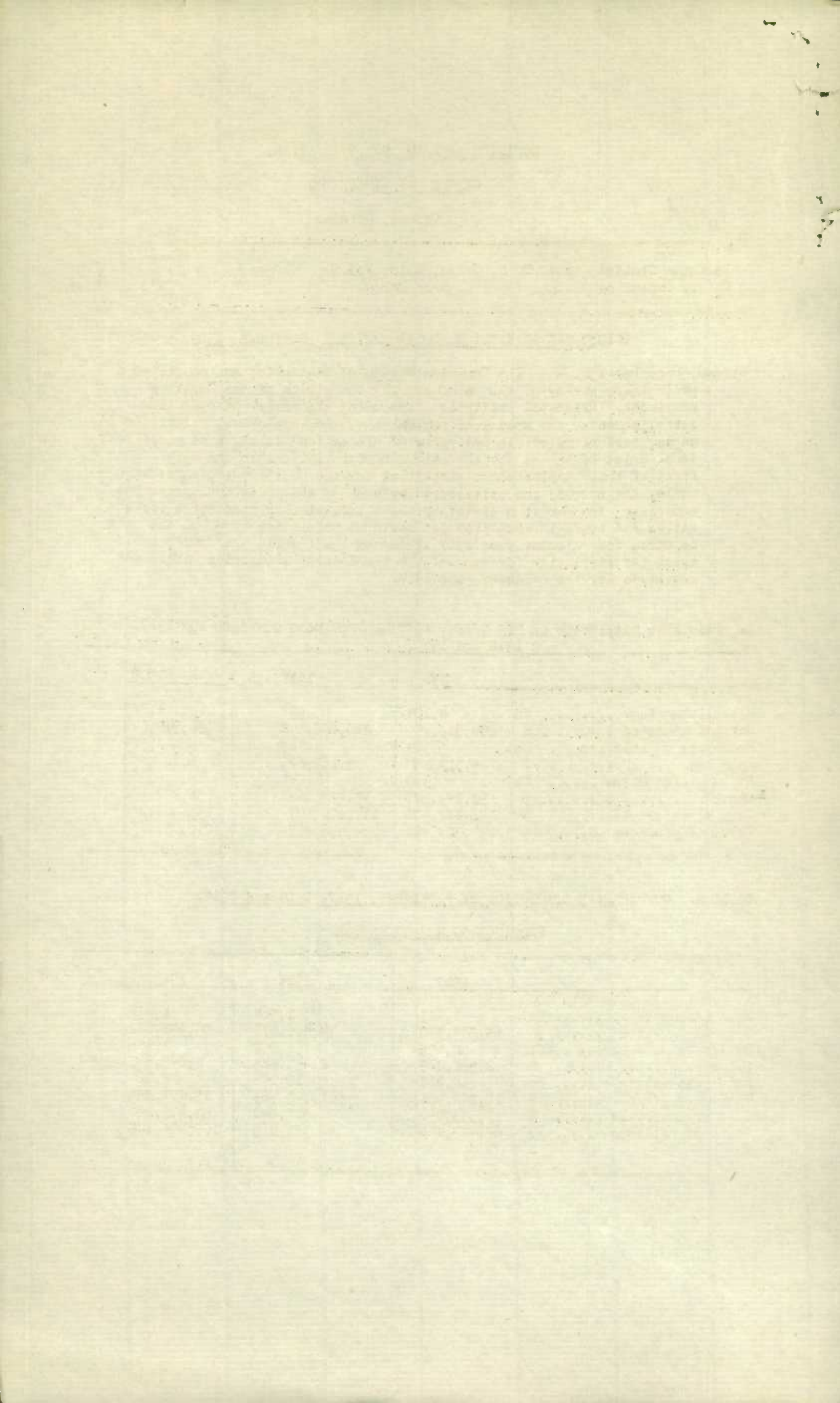

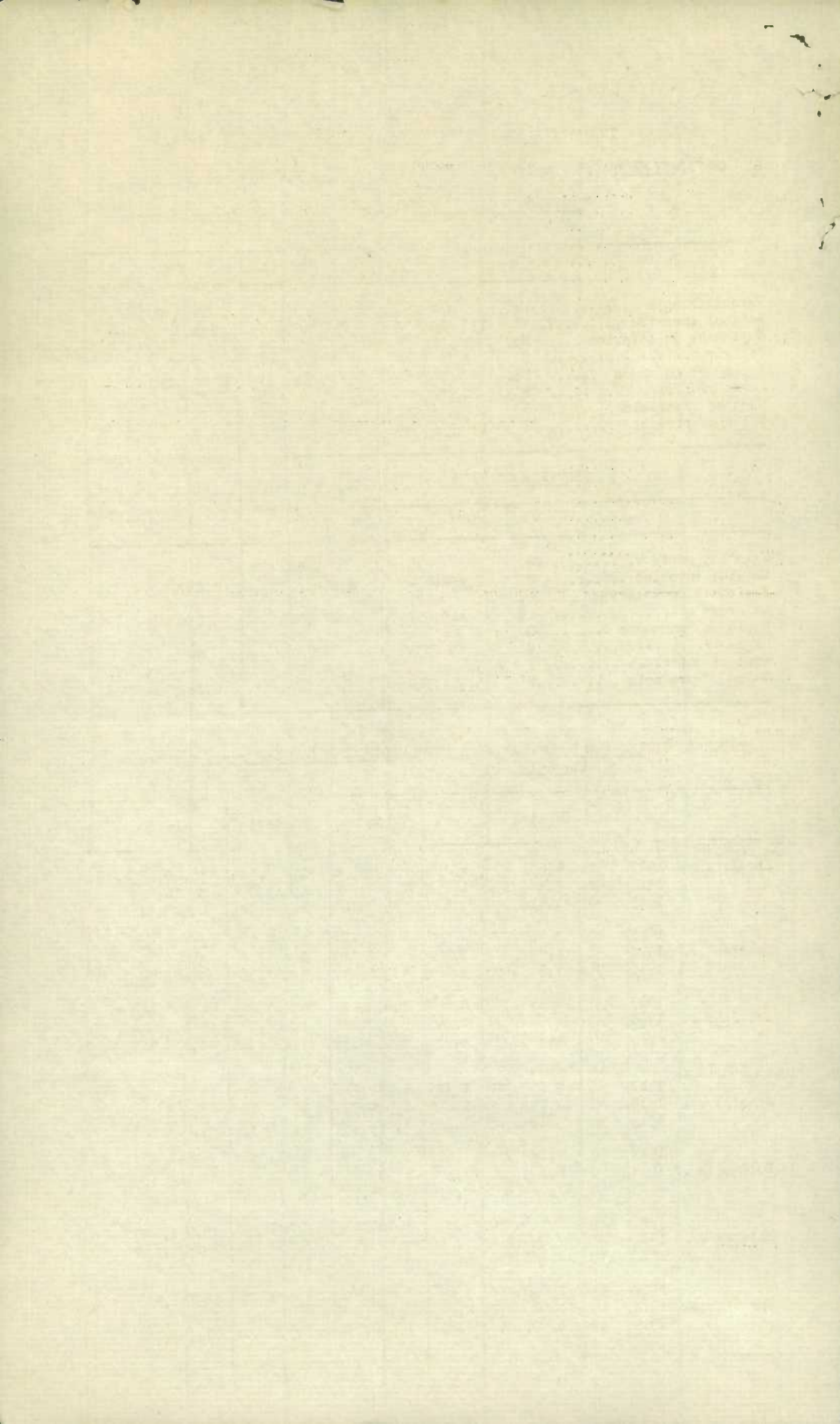
