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THE MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO,

1922.

Ottawa, August, 1924.— The principal statistics of the manufacturing industries of the Province of Ontario are presented in the following tables of this report: (1) statistics of the forty leading industries of the province, (2) statistics of manufactures by groups of industries and (3) the principal statistics of the leading cities and towns of the province.

The statistics given in this report are not comparable with those of former annual reports, owing to the omission of the construction industries, hand trades, custom clothing stores, millinery shops and repair shops, which have been omitted in the 1922 Census, but which were included in the Census of 1920.

LEADING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries in the Province of Ontario for the calendar year 1922 are presented in Table 1., arranged in order of production. Flour and grist mills occupy first place in the value of production, followed closely by the slaughtering and meat packing and automobile industries. In capital investment the electric light and power industry stands first, with pulp and paper second and agricultural implements third. In the number of persons employed on wages, the hosiery and knit goods industry was in first place, pulp and paper second and sawmills third.
