

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MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC

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Ottawa, August, 1924.—The statistics of the manufacturing industries of the province of Quebec are presented in the following series of tables, indicating the principal statistics of -

- (1) The forty leading industries.
- (2) Industrial groups.
- (3) The more important cities and towns of the province.

The statistics of 1922 are not comparable with those of previous years, owing to the omission of construction industries, hand trades, custom clothing and millinery shops and repair establishments, all of which were included in previous reports issued by the Bureau.

LEADING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries of the province are shown in Table 1. Pulp and paper production occupies first position in the province of Quebec, as it also does in the other provinces of the Dominion. Cotton textiles are next in order followed by cigars and cigarettes, both of which, like pulp and paper lead the other provinces of the Dominion in value of production. The percentage of production in the forty leading industries was 81.5 of the entire production of the province. Capital invested was 86.4 per cent, salaried employees in number 79.1 and in salaries paid 80.2 per cent, wage earners 82.1 per cent in number and 81.3 per cent in wages paid, and the cost of materials was 80 per cent.

MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1922.

The principal statistics of industries in the province of Quebec, based on the chief component material of the leading product of value in each establishment, are presented in Table 2. The number of groups in this classification has been reduced from fifteen to nine, and they correspond with the External Trade classification.
