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MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1933.

The manufacturing industries of the Province of Quebec in 1933 were able to maintain production at about the same level as the previous year. While the province continued to experience a decline in industrial activity, yet this decline was not as severe as that experienced by the Province of Ontario, the dominant manufacturing province of the Dominion. In Quebec the number of employees increased by 1.3 per cent as compared with the previous year, salaries and wages decreased by 6.7 per cent and the gross value of products by 2.3 per cent. This compares with decreases in Ontario of 1.4 per cent in the number of employees, 8.5 per cent in the salaries and wages paid and 2.2 per cent in the gross value of products.

In 1933 reports were received from 8,384 manufacturing establishments. They produced finished merchandise valued at the factory at \$653,066,534. Their capital investment amounted to \$1,648,872,387 and they furnished employment to 163,571 persons who were paid \$141,358,231 in salaries and wages. The cost of materials used was \$292,950,595 while the value added by manufacture amounted to \$360,115,939.

Compared with 1932 there was an increase of 533 in the number of establishments reporting with an increase of \$15,916,408 in the capital invested. The value of production declined by \$15,350,559 and the salaries and wages paid by \$10,122,907 while the number of employees was increased by 2,132. The cost of materials used was \$747,443 greater and the value added by manufacture \$16,098,002 lower. These variations may be noted in detail in tables 1 and 2.

The large decrease in the number of employees since 1930 is not, however, entirely due to the decline in manufacturing production. The decrease is in part due to the change in method of computing the average annual employment of wage-earners. Between 1925 and 1930 the average was obtained by summing the averages of individual plants, based on the number of months in actual operation and not by dividing by twelve the sum of the monthly employment figures. For example, if a plant operated only during three months of the year with an employment of 100 persons the first month, 125 the second month and 75 the third month, its average annual employment was taken as 100, $(300 \div 3)$, the same as that of another plant which operated the whole year with an average employment of 100 persons per month. In 1931, however, a change was made to the old method, whereby the aggregate of the monthly figures is divided by twelve. This method gives the man year that each plant operates. The change in method, therefore, affects the average annual employment as well as the average wages paid in seasonal industries, such as fruit and vegetable canning, fish canning, sawmills, etc.

Provinces where seasonal industries predominate, therefore, show a proportionately greater decrease in the number of employees in 1932 and 1933 as compared with the decrease in the salaries and wages paid, while industries that operate throughout the entire year are not affected by this change.

Table 3 compares the principal statistics of the industrial groups for the years 1932 and 1933. From the standpoint of gross value of products, the textile group headed the list with an output valued at \$143,812,971 the corresponding figures for 1932 being \$131,178,148. This increase of \$12,634,823 in the output of the textile group, is the main feature of the progress made by the manufacturing industries of the province of Quebec. Other important groups in 1933 were: vegetable products with an output of \$123,743,469, wood and paper products \$105,761,213 and animal products \$65,787,602. It will be noted that in 2 of these groups production showed a heavy decline, in comparison with 1932. The wood and paper products group reported the biggest decline, viz., \$14,165,250 while the output of central electric stations was only \$200,665 lower in 1933 as compared with the previous year.

Table 4 reviews the principal statistics of the forty leading industries of the province of Quebec in 1933. In value of production, the pulp and paper industry heads the list again with an output valued at \$56,474,428. Other leading industries are: central electric stations (\$44,519,739), cotton yarn and cloth (\$36,290,195), non-ferrous smelting and refining (\$35,058,237), tobacco cigars and cigarettes (\$31,472,1) and women's factory clothing (\$25,219,155).

Table 5 reviews the principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 3.

Table 6 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal with a production of \$300,636,197 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for nearly 50 per cent of the entire output of the province exclusive of central electric stations.

Tables 7 and 8 give the principal statistics of the industries located in Montreal and Quebec, classified according to the value of the products made.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups are shown in table 9 for 1933. Of the total capital of \$1,648,872,387, \$1,285,645,282 represents investments in land, buildings, machinery and tools. The inventory value of finished products on hand amounted to \$56,069,964 while raw materials, stocks in process, fuel and miscellaneous supplies on hand amounted to \$113,667,568. Operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and prepaid expenses, totalled \$193,489,573.

The quantity and value of fuel consumed and the power equipment of the manufacturing industries of the province of Quebec are shown in tables 10 and 11.

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STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIÈRE DE LA PROVINCE DE QUÉBEC, 1933.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de la province de Québec s'est maintenu en 1933 à environ le même niveau que l'année précédente. Quoique l'activité manufacturière se soit ralentie, le fléchissement est loin d'avoir été aussi accentué que dans l'Ontario, principale province manufacturière du Dominion.

L'effectif des établissements manufacturiers du Québec accuse un accroissement de 1.3% par rapport à 1932, alors que les déboursés en salaires et la valeur brute de la production enregistrent des moins-values respectives de 6.4% et 2.3%. Dans l'Ontario on enregistre les fléchissements suivants: effectif, 1.4%; déboursés en salaires, 8.5%; valeur brute de production, 2.2%.

Il y a 8,384 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations en 1933. Ils se partagent un chiffre de production de \$653,066,534. Les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,648,872,387; effectifs, 163,571 unités; déboursés en salaires, \$141,358,231; achats de matières premières, \$292,950,595; valeur ajoutée par la transformation, \$360,115,939.

Comparativement à 1932, le nombre de déclarants a augmenté de 533 et les capitaux engagés de \$15,916,408; la valeur de production a diminué de \$15,350,559 et les déboursés en salaires de \$10,122,907; les effectifs ont augmenté de 2,132 unités. Les achats de matières premières accusent une plus-value de \$747,443 alors que la valeur ajoutée par la transformation a fléchi de \$16,098,002. Ces variations figurent en détail aux tableaux 1 et 2.

La diminution marquée des effectifs depuis 1930 n'est toutefois pas attribuable en entier au ralentissement de la production manufacturière, mais, dans une large mesure, aux modifications apportées dans les méthodes qui président au calcul de la moyenne de l'emploi annuel des employés à gages. Durant la période 1925-30, on calculait la moyenne en additionnant les moyennes de chaque établissement, moyennes qui étaient fondées sur le nombre de mois d'exploitation effective et non pas en divisant par douze le total des données mensuelles. Dans le cas où un établissement n'était en exploitation que trois mois de l'année, occupant 100 personnes le premier mois, 125 le second et 75 le troisième, la moyenne annuelle était calculée à 100 (300:3), soit la même moyenne qu'un établissement en exploitation l'année entière et occupant une moyenne de 100 personnes par mois. En 1931 toutefois, on revint à l'ancienne méthode selon laquelle le total des chiffres mensuels est divisé par douze. D'après cette méthode, on obtient l'homme-année que chaque établissement était en exploitation. Cette modification influence par conséquent la moyenne de l'emploi annuel ainsi que la moyenne des salaires des industries d'ordre saisonnier, telles que les conserveries de fruits et de légumes, les conserveries de poisson, les scieries, etc.

Les provinces où les industries saisonnières prédominent accusent ainsi en 1932 et 1933 des réductions relativement plus marquées des effectifs que les déboursés

en salaires, alors que les industries fonctionnant l'année entière ne subissent pas l'influence de ce changement.

Le tableau 3 contient les principales statistiques des groupes industriels pour 1933 juxtaposées aux données de 1932. Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de production, les textiles se classent au premier rang avec \$143,812,971 au lieu de \$131,178,148 en 1932. Cette plus-value de \$12,634,823 est le point saillant de l'essor de l'industrie manufacturière dans la province de Québec. Parmi les autres groupes importants, mentionnons les substances végétales, avec un chiffre de production de \$123,743,469; transformations du bois et applications du papier, \$105,761,213; produits animaux, \$65,787,602. A noter que deux de ces postes enregistrent des moins-values accentuées par rapport à 1932; les transformations du bois et les applications du papier accusent le fléchissement le plus marqué, soit \$14,165,250. La production des centrales électriques n'a diminué que de \$200,665 sur 1932.

Figurent au tableau 4 les principales statistiques des quarante industries importantes en 1933. Les valeurs de production les plus élevées sont enregistrées par les suivantes: pâte et papier, \$56,474,428; centrales électriques, \$44,519,739; filés de coton et cotonnades, \$36,290,195; réduction et affinage des métaux autres que le fer, \$35,058,237; tabacs, cigares et cigarettes, \$31,472,192; confection pour dames, \$25,219,155.

Le tableau 5 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 3.

Le tableau 6 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$300,636,197 se place bonne première avec près de 50% du grand total sans les centrales électriques.

Les tableaux 7 et 8 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec, classées selon la valeur de production.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 9. Sur un grand total de \$1,648,872,387, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$1,285,645,282; valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, \$56,069,964; matières premières, stocks en voie de transformation, combustible et divers, \$113,667,568; capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$193,489,573.

La consommation de combustible et l'outillage de force motrice des industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 10 et 11.
