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MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1934.

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$766,498,000 in 1934 represents an increase of 17.4 per cent as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 8,168 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,678,486,302. The number of persons employed totalled 181,546 and the salaries and wages paid \$161,197,908 while the cost of materials used and value added by manufacture were \$357,751,720 and \$336,407,772 respectively.

The turning point of the depression was reached in the summer of 1933 with the result that the number of employees for that year was slightly higher than the previous year. In the case of value of production, however, the increase in the latter part of the year was not sufficiently pronounced to offset the losses of the beginning of the year. The value of production was, therefore, at the lowest point since 1929. Compared with the previous year there was an increase in 1934 of 11.0 per cent in the number of employees with an even greater increase in the salaries and wages paid which amounted to 14.0 per cent. The increase in the value of production was 17.4 per cent and in the value added by manufacture 13.1 per cent.

In analysing the improvement affected by the major industrial groups, it is found that the iron and its products group with an increase of 24.8 per cent in the gross value of production recorded the greatest gain. Non-metallic minerals with an increase of 24.7 per cent was a very close second, followed by animal products with 24.6 per cent, wood and paper products 21.7 per cent, textiles 18.2 per cent, chemicals 16.7 per cent, non-ferrous metals 13.3 per cent, vegetable products 9.1 per cent and central electric stations 5.2 per cent.

Quebec with about 30 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 10 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 49 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of cotton yarn and cloth forms approximately 69 per cent, railway rolling stock 45 per cent, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes 85 per cent, and leather boots and shoes 58 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of production, the textile industries with an output valued at \$169,967,889 again heads the list. Other groups in order of their importance are: vegetable products \$134,962,261, wood and paper \$128,603,202, animal products \$82,005,075, non-metallic mineral products \$57,108,642, iron and its products \$53,922,917, etc. Further details are given in table 3 which compares the principal statistics of the industrial groups for the years 1933 and 1934.

Table 4 reviews the principal statistics of the forty leading industries of the province of Quebec in 1934. In value of production, the pulp and paper industry heads the list again with an output valued at \$74,407,960. Other leading industries are: central electric stations (\$46,818,247), cotton yarn and cloth (\$42,463,877), non-ferrous smelting and refining (\$36,230,880), tobacco, cigars and cigarettes (\$31,995,548), and women's factory clothing (\$30,868,071).

Table 5 reviews the principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 3.

MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1934.

Table 6 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal with a production of \$361,058,212 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for more than 50 per cent of the entire output of the province exclusive of central electric stations.

Tables 7 and 8 give the principal statistics of the industries located in Montreal and Quebec, classified according to the value of the products made.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups are shown in table 9 for 1934. Of the total capital of \$1,678,486,302, \$1,320,070,198 represents investments in land, buildings, machinery and tools. The inventory value of finished products on hand amounted to \$58,098,638 while raw materials, stocks in process, fuel and miscellaneous supplies on hand amounted to \$118,128,763. Operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and prepaid expenses, totalled \$182,188,703.

The quantity and value of fuel consumed and the power equipment of the manufacturing industries of the province of Quebec are shown in tables 10 and 11.

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STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIÈRE DE LA PROVINCE DE QUÉBEC, 1934.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de la province de Québec, qui s'élève à \$766,498,000 en 1934, accuse une augmentation de 17.4 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 8,168 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations; les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,678,486,302; les effectifs, à \$181,546; les déboursés en salaires et gages, à \$161,197,908; le coût des matières premières, à \$357,751,720 et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, à \$336,407,772.

La première accélération dans les activités manufacturières se fit sentir à l'été de 1933 et le nombre d'employés pour cette année fut, en conséquence, un peu plus élevé. Pour ce qui est de la valeur de la production, les gains dans les derniers mois de l'année ne furent cependant pas assez considérables pour contrebalancer les pertes du commencement de l'année. La valeur de la production tomba en 1933 au niveau le plus bas qu'elle ait touché depuis la dépression. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre une augmentation de 11.0 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et une augmentation encore plus importante dans les sommes payées en rémunération au personnel, soit 14.0 p.c. L'augmentation en valeur brute de la production est de 17.4 p.c. et 13.1 p.c. en valeur ajoutée par la transformation.

Une analyse de l'amélioration dans chacun des groupes les plus importants montre que le groupe des "produits du fer et de l'acier", avec une augmentation de 24.8 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production, se classe au premier rang. Le groupe des "métalloïdes" le suit de près avec une augmentation de 24.7 p.c. Le pourcentage d'augmentation pour les "produits animaux" est de 24.6 p.c.; "produits du bois et du papier" 21.7 p.c.; "textiles" 18.2 p.c.; "produits chimiques" 16.7 p.c.; "métaux non ferreux" 13.3 p.c.; "substances végétales" 9.1 p.c. et "centrales électriques" 5.2 p.c.

Le Québec, avec 30 p.c. de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 10 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 49 p.c. de la production de pulpe et de papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des tissus et filés de coton représente approximativement 69 p.c. de la production totale du Canada; le matériel roulant de chemins de fer, 45 p.c.; le tabac, les cigares et les cigarettes, 85 p.c. et les chaussures en cuir 58 p.c. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec une production de \$169,967,889. Parmi les autres groupes importants mentionnons: les "substances végétales" avec un chiffre de production de \$134,962,261; "produits du bois et du papier" \$128,603,202; "produits animaux" \$82,005,075; "métalloïdes" \$57,108,642; "fer et ses dérivés" \$53,922,917, etc. Le tableau 3 contient les principales statistiques de chacun des groupes d'industries pour 1933 et 1934.

Figurent au tableau 4 les principales statistiques des quarante industries les plus importantes en 1934. Les valeurs de production les plus élevées sont enregistrées par les suivantes: pâte et papier, \$74,407,960; centrales électriques, \$46,818,247; filés de coton et cotonnades, \$42,463,877; réduction et affinage des métaux autres que le fer, \$36,230,880; tabacs, cigares et cigarettes, \$31,995,548; confection pour femmes, \$30,868,071.

Le tableau 5 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 3.

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STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIERE DE LA PROVINCE DE QUEBEC, 1934.

Le tableau 6 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$361,058,212 se place bonne première avec près de 50 p.c. du grand total sans les centrales électriques.

Les tableaux 7 et 8 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec, classées selon la valeur de production.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 9. Sur un grand total de \$1,678,486,302, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$1,320,070,198; valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, \$58,098,638; matières premières, stocks en voie de transformation, combustible et divers, \$118,128,763; capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$182,188,703.

La consommation de combustible et l'outillage de force motrice des industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 10 et 11.

* The large decrease in the number of employees since 1931 is not entirely due to the decline in manufacturing production. The decrease is in part due to the change in method of computing the average annual employment of wage-earners. Between 1925 and 1930 the average was obtained by summing the averages of individual plants, based on the number of months in actual operation, and not by dividing by twelve the sum of the monthly employment figures. In 1931, however, a change was made to the old method whereby the aggregate of the monthly figures is divided by 12. This method gives the man year that each plant operates. The change in method, therefore, affects the average annual employment as well as the average wages paid in seasonal industries, such as fruit and vegetable canning, fish canning, sawmills, etc.

La forte diminution dans le nombre d'employés depuis 1931 n'est pas due entièrement au déclin de la production manufacturière. Elle provient partiellement du changement de méthode de calcul de l'emploi annuel des employés à gages. Entre 1925 et 1930 la moyenne générale était obtenue en additionnant les moyennes de chaque établissement basées sur le nombre de mois d'opérations au lieu de diviser par 12 les chiffres totaux de l'emploi mensuel. En 1931 cependant cette méthode a été changée et le total des chiffres mensuels est divisé par 12. Cette méthode donne le nombre d'homme-année pour chaque établissement. Cette modification par conséquent affecte la moyenne d'emploi annuel aussi bien que les moyennes de gages et salaires dans les industries saisonnières telles que les conserveries de fruits et légumes, les conserveries de poisson, les scieries, etc.

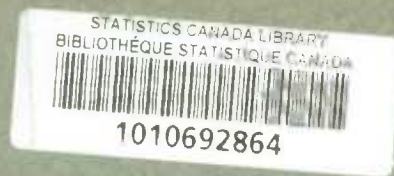
