MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1935.

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$821,020,796 in 1935 represents an increase of 7.1 per cent as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 7,942 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,664,198,107. The number of persons employed totalled 189,671 and the salaries and wages paid \$173,354,585 while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$398,566,702 and \$393,805,691 respectively.

The turning point of the depression was reached in the summer of 1933 with the result that the number of employees for that year was slightly higher than the previous year. In the case of value of production, however, the increase in the latter part of the year was not sufficiently pronounced to offset the losses of the beginning of the year. The value of production was, therefore, at the lowest point since 1929. Compared with the previous year there was an increase in 1935 of 4.5 per cent in the number of employees with an even greater increase in the salaries and wages paid which amounted to 7.5 per cent. The increase in the value of production was 7.1 per cent and in the value added by manufacture 3.5 per cent. A change was made in the method of calculating the net value of production in the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining industry. The increase in 1935 is, therefore, lower than what it would have been by the old method.

In analysing the improvement affected by the major industrial groups, it is found that the non-ferrous metal products group with an increase of 21.7 per cent in the gross value of production recorded the greatest gain. The iron and its products group with an increase of 15.8 per cent came next, followed by wood and paper products with 6.9 per cent, vegetable products 6.6 per cent, non-metallic mineral products 6.5 per cent, animal products 5.3 per cent and textiles 4.8 per cent.

Quebec with about 30 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 10 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 48 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of cotton yarn and cloth forms approximately 70 per cent, railway rolling stock 44 per cent, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes 85 per cent, and leather boots and shoes 58 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries with an output valued at \$178,226,210 again heads the list. Other groups in order of their importance are: vegetable products \$143,918,743, wood and paper products \$137,439,586, animal products \$86,336,284, non-ferrous metal products \$69,505,463 and iron and its products \$62,427,355. Details are given in table 3 which compares the principal statistics of the industrial groups for the years 1934 and 1935.

Table 4 reviews the principal statistics of the forty leading industries of the province of Quebec. In value of production, the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$78,701,994. Other leading industries are: central electric stations, \$47,808,550; non-ferrous metal smelting and refining, \$45,565,844; cotton yarn and cloth, \$41,660,189; tobacco, cigars and cigarettes, \$33,358,806 and women's factory clothing, \$32,912,629.

Table 5 reviews the principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 3.

Table 6 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper, with a production of \$383,138,191 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for about 47 per cent of the entire output of the province, exclusive of central electric stations.

Tables 7 and 8 give the principal statistics of the industries located in Montreal and Quebec City ranked according to the value of the products made.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups are shown for 1935 in table 9. Of the total capital investment of \$1,664,198,107, \$1,300,535,330 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$181,724,529 while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$181,938,248.

The quantity and value of fuel consumed is given in table 10 and the power equipment in table 11.

STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIÈRE DE LA PROVINCE DE QUÉBEC, 1935.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de la province de Québec, qui s'élève à \$821,020,796 en 1935, accuse une augmentation de 7.1 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 7,942 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations; les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,664,198,107, les effectifs, à 189,671, les déboursés en salaires et gages, à \$173,354,585, le coût des matières premières, à \$398,566,702 et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, à \$393,805,691.

La première accélération dans les activités manufacturières se fit sentir à l'été de 1933 et le nombre d'employés pour cette année fut, en conséquence, un peu plus élevé. Pour ce qui est de la valeur de la production, les gains dans les derniers mois de l'année ne furent cependant pas assez considérables pour contre-balancer les pertes du commencement de l'année. La valeur de la production tomba en 1933 au niveau le plus bas qu'elle ait touché depuis la dépression. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre en 1935 une augmentation de 4.5 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et une augmentation encore plus importante dans les sommes payées en rémunération au personnel, soit 7.5 p.c. L'augmentation en valeur brute de la production est de 7.1 p.c. et 3.5 p.c. en valeur ajoutée par la transformation. La façon de calculer la valeur nette de la production pour l'industrie de la réduction et de l'affinage des métaux non-ferreux ayant été changée, l'augmentation en 1935 est moins élevée qu'elle ne l'aurait été d'après l'ancienne méthode.

Une analyse de l'amélioration dans chacun des groupes les plus importants montre que le groupe des "métaux non-ferreux", avec une augmentation de 21.7 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production, se classe au premier rang. Le groupe du fer et des produits suit avec une augmentation de 15.8 p.c. Le pourcentage d'augmentation pour les "produits du bois et du papier" est de 6.9 p.c.; "substances végétales" 6.6 p.c.; "métalloïdes" 6.5 p.c.; "produits animaux" 5.3 p.c. et "textiles" 4.8 p.c.

Le Québec, avec environ 30 p.c. de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 10 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 48 p.c. de la production de pulpe et de papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des tissus et filés de coton représente approximativement 70 p.c. de la production totale du Canada; le matériel roulant de chemins de fer, 44 p.c.; le tabac, les cigares et les cigarettes, 85 p.c. et les chaussures en cuir 58 p.c. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec une production de \$178,226,210. Parmi les autres groupes importants mentionnons: les "substances végétales" avec un chiffre de production de \$143,918,743; "produits du bois et du papier" \$137,439,586; "produits animaux" \$86,336,284; "métaux non-ferreux" \$69,505,463; "fer et ses dérivés" \$62,427,355, etc. Le tableau 3 contient les principales statistiques de chacun des groupes d'industries pour 1934 et 1935.

Figurent au tableau 4 les principales statistiques des quarante industries les plus importantes en 1935. Les valeurs de production les plus élevées sont enregistrées par les suivantes: pâte et papier, \$78,701,994; centrales électriques, \$47,808,550; réduction et affinage des métaux autres que le fer, \$45,565,844; filés de coton et cotonnades, \$41,660,189; tabacs, cigares et cigarettes, \$33,358,806; confection pour femmes, \$32,912,629.

Le tableau 5 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 3.

Le tableau 6 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$383,138,191 se place bonne première avec près de 47 p.c. du grand total sans les centrales électriques.

Les tableaux 7 et 8 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec, classées selon la valeur de production.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 9. Sur un grand total de \$1,664,198,107, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$1,300,535,330; valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$181,724,529, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$181,938,248.

La consommation de combustible et l'outillage de force motrice des industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 10 et 11.
