Since 1936 the Census of Manufactures does not include "central electric stations" and "dyeing, cleaning and laundry work". 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MANUFACTURING STATISTICS OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1936.

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$863,687,389 in 1936 represents an increase of 12.3 per cent as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 7,969 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,029,546,039. The number of persons employed totalled 194,876 and the salaries and wages paid \$182,319,454 while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$455,027,759 and \$377,514,998 respectively.

The turning point of the depression was reached in the summer of 1933 with the result that the number of employees for that year was slightly higher than the previous year. In the case of value of production, however, the increase in the latter part of the year was not sufficiently pronounced to offset the losses of the beginning of the year. The value of production was, therefore, at the lowest point since 1929. Compared with the previous year there was an increase in 1936 of 6.5 per cent in the number of employees with an even greater increase in the salaries and wages paid which amounted to 9.9 per cent. The increase in the value of production was 12.3 per cent and in the value added by manufacture 10.2 per cent. In spite of the improvement of the past three years, the number of persons employed and the salaries and wages paid are still below the 1929 level by 5.5 per cent and 18.7 per cent respectively.

In analysing the improvement affected by the major industrial groups in 1936, it is found that the iron and its products group with an increase of 26.6 per cent in the gross value of production recorded the greatest gain. The non-ferrous metal products group with an increase of 18.6 per cent came second followed by non-metallic mineral products with 13.4 per cent, wood and paper products 12.9 per cent, animal products 12.8 per cent, chemicals 10.7 per cent, textiles 8.7 per cent and vegetable products 6.4 per cent.

Quebec with about 29 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 10 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 48 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of cotton yarn and cloth forms approximately 70 per cent, railway rolling stock 46 per cent, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes 85 per cent, and leather boots and shoes 58 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries with an output valued at \$189,206,601 again head the list. Other groups in order of their importance are: vegetable products \$159,431,053, wood and paper products \$155,079,459, animal products \$97,355,266, iron and its products \$82,684,309 and non-ferrous metal products \$82,417,242. Details are given in table 3, comparing the principal statistics of the industrial groups for the years 1935 and 1936.

Table 4 reviews the principal statistics of the forty leading industries in the province of Quebec. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$88,854,952. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining, \$54,296,636; cotton yarn and cloth, \$45,534,135; women's factory clothing, \$35,919,769 and tobacco, cigars and cigarettes, \$34,156,617.

Table 5 reviews the principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 3.

Table 6 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a production of \$427,270,916 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for about 49 per cent of the entire output of the province.

Tables 7 and 8 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec, ranked according to the value of the products made.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups are shown for 1936 in table 9. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,029,546,039, \$678,213,293 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$189,435,373 while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$161,897,373.

The quantity and value of fuel and electricity consumed is given in table 10 and the power equipment in table 11.

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STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIERE DE LA PROVINCE DE QUEBEC, 1936.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de la province de Québec, qui s'élève à \$863,687,389 en 1936, accuse une augmentation de 12.3 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 7,969 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations; les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,029,546,039, les effectifs, à 194,876, les déboursés en salaires et gages, à \$182,319,454, le coût des matières premières, à \$455,027,759 et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, à \$377,514,998.

La première accélération dans les activités manufacturières se fit sentir à l'été de 1933 et le nombre d'employés pour cette année fut, en conséquence, un peu plus élevé. Pour ce qui est de la valeur de la production, les gains dans les derniers mois de l'année ne furent cependant pas assez considérables pour contre-balancer les pertes du commencement de l'année. La valeur de la production tomba en 1933 au niveau le plus bas qu'elle ait touché depuis la dépression. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre en 1936 une augmentation de 6.5 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et une augmentation encore plus importante dans les sommes payées en rémunération au personnel, soit 9.9 p.c. L'augmentation en valeur brute de la production est de 12.3 p.c. et 10.2 p.c. en valeur ajoutée par la transformation. En dépit de l'amélioration au cours des trois dernières années le nombre d'employés, les salaires et les gages restent encore en dessous du niveau de 1929 par 5.5 p.c. et 18.7 p.c. respectivement.

Une analyse de l'amélioration dans chacun des groupes les plus importants montre que le groupe du fer et ses produits avec une augmentation de 26.6 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production se classe au premier rang. Le groupe des "Métaux non ferreux" suit avec une augmentation de 18.6 p.c. Le pourcentage d'augmentation pour les "Métalloïdes" est de 13.4 p.c., "Produits du bois et du papier" 12.9 p.c., "Produits animaux" 12.8 p.c., "Produits chimiques" 10.7 p.c., "Textiles" 8.7 p.c. et "Substances végétales" 6.4 p.c.

Le Québec, avec environ 29 p.c. de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 10 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 48 p.c. de la production de pulpe et de papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des tissus et filés de coton représente approximativement 70 p.c. de la production totale du Canada; le matériel roulant de chemins de fer, 46 p.c.; le tabac, les cigares et les cigarettes, 85 p.c. et les chaussures en cuir 58 p.c. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec une production de \$189,206,601. Parmi les autres groupes importants mentionnons: les "Substances végétales" avec un chiffre de production de \$159,431,053; "Produits du bois et du papier" \$155,079,459; "Produits animaux" \$97,355,266; "Fer et ses dérivés" \$82,684,309 et les "Métaux non ferreux" \$82,417,242. Le tableau 3 contient les principales statistiques de chacun des groupes d'industries pour 1935 et 1936.

Figurent au tableau 4, les principales statistiques des quarante industries les plus importantes en 1936. L'industrie de la Pulpe et du papier arrive encore première avec \$88,854,952 en valeur de production. Les autres industries se classent dans l'ordre suivant: Réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux \$54,296,636; filés de coton et cotonnades \$45,534,135; Confection pour femmes \$35,919,769 et Tabac, cigares et cigarettes \$34,156,617.

Le tableau 5 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 3.

Le tableau 6 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$427,270,916 se place bonne première avec près de 49 p.c. du grand total.

Les tableaux 7 et 8 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec, classées selon la valeur de production.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 9. Sur un grand total de \$1,029,546,039, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$678,213,293, valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$189,435,373, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$161,897,373.

La consommation de combustible et d'électricité et l'outillage de force motrice des industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 10 et 11.
