MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE  
OF QUEBEC, 1937.

STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIÈRE DE LA PROVINCE  
DE QUEBEC, 1937.

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$1,046,470,796 in 1937 represents an increase of 21.2 per cent as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 8,518 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,117,772,721. The number of persons employed totalled 219,033 and the salaries and wages paid \$216,971,207, while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$562,889,160 and \$445,885,666 respectively.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de la province de Québec, qui s'élève à \$1,046,470,796 en 1937, accuse une augmentation de 21.2 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 8,518 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations; les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,117,772,721, les effectifs, à 219,033, les déboursés en salaires et gages, à \$216,971,207, le coût des matières premières, à \$562,889,160 et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, à \$445,885,666.

The upward climb in manufacturing production begun in the summer of 1933 was greatly accelerated in 1937. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of 21.2 per cent in the gross value of production, 18.1 per cent in the value added by manufacture, 12.4 per cent in the number of persons employed and 19.0 per cent in the salaries and wages paid. In many respects 1937 was a record year. The number of employees at 219,033 represents an all-time high for the manufacturing industries of Quebec, exceeding by 12,959 the previous high record attained in 1929. Salary and wage payments, although substantially higher than for a number of years, are still, however, about 3 per cent below the 1929 level. The physical volume of production is also the highest on record. It is estimated that the volume in 1937 was about 9 per cent greater than in 1929. However, due to a drop of 13.4 per cent in the prices of fully and chiefly manufactured products, the gross value of production is still 5.4 per cent below the 1929 figure.

L'essor de la production manufacturière commencé à l'été de 1933 s'est grandement accéléré en 1937. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre une augmentation de 21.2 p.c. dans la valeur brute des produits, 18.1 p.c. dans la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, 12.4 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et 19.0 p.c. dans les sommes payées en rémunération, au personnel. A plusieurs points de vue, 1937 fut une année sommet. Les effectifs de 219,033 atteignent un niveau sans précédent dans l'histoire de la production manufacturière de la province de Québec, dépassant par 12,959 le record de 1929. Les salaires et gages bien que sensiblement plus élevés depuis un certain nombre d'années sont encore de 3 p.c. inférieurs à ceux de 1929. Le volume physique de la production atteint aussi un niveau sans précédent. On estime qu'il est en 1937 de 9 p.c. au-dessus de celui de 1929. Toutefois, en raison d'une baisse de prix de 13.4 p.c. dans les produits entièrement ou partiellement ouvrés, la valeur brute de la production est encore de 5.4 p.c. inférieure à celle de 1929.

In analysing the improvement affected by the major industrial groups in 1937, it is found that the iron and its products group with an increase of 51.9 per cent in the gross value of production recorded the greatest gain. The non-ferrous metal products group with an increase of 33.8 per cent came second, followed by miscellaneous industries group with 25.5 per cent, wood and paper products 23.6 per cent, non-metallic mineral products 22.4 per cent, chemicals 17.2 per cent, animal products 14.8 per cent, vegetable products 14.6 per cent and textiles 9.3 per cent.

Une analyse de l'amélioration dans chacun des groupes montre que le groupe du "Fer et ses produits avec une augmentation de 51.9 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production se classe au premier rang. Le groupe des "Métaux non ferreux" suit avec une augmentation de 33.8 p.c. Le pourcentage d'augmentation pour le groupe des "Industries diverses" est de 25.5 p.c.; "Bois et papier" 23.6 p.c.; "Métalloïdes", 22.4 p.c.; "Produits chimiques", 17.2 p.c.; "Produits animaux", 14.8 p.c.; "Substances végétales", 14.6 p.c. et "Textiles", 9.3 p.c.

Quebec with about 29 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is

the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 10 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 47 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of cotton yarn and cloth forms approximately 69 per cent, railway rolling stock 48 per cent, tobacco products 85 per cent, women's factory clothing 66 per cent, and leather boots and shoes 61 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries with an output valued at \$206,893,813 again headed the list. Other groups in order of their importance are: wood and paper products \$191,688,101, vegetable products \$182,657,838, iron and its products \$125,576,959, animal products \$111,760,730, non-ferrous metal products \$110,296,455, non-metallic mineral products \$61,309,188, chemicals \$45,096,665 and miscellaneous industries \$11,191,047.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in table 4. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$107,196,316. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining, \$69,800,390; cotton yarn and cloth, \$49,815,471; railway rolling stock, \$45,313,773; women's factory clothing, \$40,077,126; and tobacco, cigars and cigarettes, \$38,338,640.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 3 are reviewed in table 5.

Table 6 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a production of \$511,481,054 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for about 49 per cent of the entire output of the province.

Tables 7 and 8 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups for 1937 are shown in table 9. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,117,772,721, \$711,072,474 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$225,435,702, while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$181,264,545.

Statistics of fuel and electricity consumed are given in table 11 and power equipment in table 10.

La valeur des tissus et filés de coton représente approximativement 69 p.c. de la production totale du Canada; le matériel roulant de chemin de fer, 48 p.c.; le tabac, les cigares et les cigarettes, 85 p.c.; la confection pour femmes, 66 p.c.; et les chaussures en cuir 61 p.c. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec une production de \$206,893,813. Parmi les autres groupes importants mentionnons: "Produits du bois et du papier" avec un chiffre de production de \$191,688,101; "Substances végétales" \$182,657,838; "Fer et ses produits" \$125,576,959; "Produits animaux" \$111,760,730; "Métaux non ferreux" \$110,296,455; "Métalloïdes" \$61,309,188; "Produits chimiques" \$45,096,665 et "Industries diverses" \$11,191,047.

Figurent au tableau 4, les principales statistiques des quarante industries les plus importantes en 1937. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier arrive encore première avec \$107,196,316 en valeur de production. Les autres industries se classent dans l'ordre suivant: Réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux \$69,800,390; Filés de coton et cotonnades \$49,815,471; Matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$45,313,773; Confection pour femmes \$40,077,126; et Tabac, cigares et cigarettes, \$38,338,640.

Le tableau 5 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 3.

Le tableau 6 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$511,481,054 se place bonne première avec près de 49 p.c. du grand total.

Les tableaux 7 et 8 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec, classées selon la valeur de production.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 9. Sur un grand total de \$1,117,772,721, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$711,072,474, valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$225,435,702, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$181,264,545.

L'outillage de force motrice et la consommation de combustible et d'électricité dans les industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 10 et 11.
