MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE
OF QUEBEC, 1938.

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$983,123,599 in 1938 represents a decrease of 6.0 per cent as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 8,655 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,-146,235,084. The number of persons employed totalled 214,397 and the salaries and wages paid \$213,390,084, while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$518,430,815 and \$428,614,079 respectively.

The upward climb in manufacturing production begun in the summer of 1933 was greatly accelerated in 1937. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of 21.2 per cent in the gross value of production, 18.1 per cent in the value added by manufacture, 12.4 per cent in the number of persons employed and 19.0 per cent in the salaries and wages paid. In many respects 1937 was a record year. The number of employees at 219,033 represented an all-time high for the manufacturing industries of Quebec, exceeding by 12,959 the previous high record attained in 1929. Salary and wage payments, although substantially higher than for a number of years, were still, however, about 3 per cent below the 1929 level. The physical volume of production was also the highest on record. It is estimated that the volume in 1937 was about 14 per cent greater than in 1929. However, due to a drop of 13.4 per cent in the prices of fully and chiefly manufactured products, the gross value of production was still 5.4 per cent below the 1929 figures.

In 1938 a minor recession was experienced. There was a decrease of 2.1 per cent in the number of persons employed, 1.7 per cent in the salaries and wages paid, 3.9 per cent in the net value and 6.0 per cent in the gross value of production. In analysing the effects of this recession on the major industrial groups, it is found, that compared with 1937, the iron and its products group with a decrease of 13.5 per cent in the gross value of production was the most severely affected. Textiles and textile products with a drop of 10.8 per cent came second, followed by wood and paper products with 9.9 per cent, miscellaneous industries group 7.4 per cent, non-metallic mineral products 4.0 per cent, animal products 3.2 per cent and vegetable and chemical products with .9 per cent each. The value of production of non-ferrous metal products, however, was 3.5 per cent higher.

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STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIERE DE LA PROVINCE
DE QUÉBEC, 1938.

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de cette province qui s'élève à \$983,123,599 en 1938 accuse une diminution de 6.0 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 8,655 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations; les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,146,235,084, les effectifs à 214,397 et les salaires et gages à \$213,390,084, les matières employées à \$518,430,815 et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation à \$428,614,079.

L'essor de la production manufacturière commencé à l'été de 1933 s'est grandement accéléré en 1937. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre une augmentation de 21.2 p.c. dans la valeur brute des produits, 18.1 p.c. dans la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, 12.4 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et 19.0 p.c. dans les sommes payées en rémunération, au personnel. A plusieurs points de vue, 1937 fut une année sommet. Les effectifs de 219,033 atteignirent un niveau sans précédent dans l'histoire de la production manufacturière de la province de Québec, dépassant par 12,959 le record de 1929. Les salaires et gages bien que sensiblement plus élevés depuis un certain nombre d'années furent encore de 3 p.c. inférieurs à ceux de 1929. Le volume physique de la production atteint aussi un niveau sans précédent. On estime qu'il était en 1937 de 14 p.c. au-dessus de celui de 1929. Toutefois, en raison d'une baisse de prix de 13.4 p.c. dans les produits entièrement ou partiellement ouvrés, la valeur brute de la production était encore de 5.4 p.c. inférieure à celle de 1929.

En 1938 une légère diminution s'est fait sentir comme suit: 2.1 p.c. dans le nombre des employés, 1.7 p.c. dans les salaires et gages, 3.9 p.c. dans la valeur nette des produits et 6.0 p.c. dans la valeur brute. Une analyse de cette régression dans les différents groupes montre que le groupe du "Fer et ses produits" avec une diminution de 13.5 p.c. dans la valeur de ses produits a été le plus sérieusement affecté. Ce groupe est suivi par celui des "Textiles et leurs produits" avec une baisse de 10.8 p.c.; "Bois et papier" avec une baisse de 9.9 p.c.; "Industries diverses" 7.4 p.c.; "Métalloïdes", 4.0 p.c.; "Produits animaux", 3.2 p.c.; "Produits végétaux" et "Produits chimiques", .9 p.c. respectivement. La valeur de la production dans les "Métaux non ferreux" fut cependant de 3.5 p.c. plus élevée.

Quebec with about 29 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 9 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 43 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products forms approximately 87 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 69 per cent, women's factory clothing 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 60 per cent and railway rolling-stock 47 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries with an output valued at \$184,536,427 again headed the list. Other major groups in order of their importance are: Vegetable products \$181,016,203, wood and paper products \$172,740,836, non-ferrous metal products \$114,110,551, iron and its products \$108,579,370, animal products \$108,218,282, non-metallic mineral products \$58,883,761, chemicals \$44,675,929 and miscellaneous industries \$10,362,240.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in table 5. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$88,990,115. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining \$78,-954,445, cotton yarn and cloth \$39,568,088, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$39,156,515, women's factory clothing \$39,113,490, railway rolling-stock \$37,874,224, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 4 are reviewed in table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a production of \$474,534,092 leads by a very wide margin, accounting for about 48 per cent of the entire output of the province.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups for 1938 are shown in table 10. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,146,235,084, \$731,183,518 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$227,567,574, while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$187,483,992.

Statistics of fuel and electricity consumed are given in table 12 and power equipment in table 11.

Le Québec avec environ 29 p.c. de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 9 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 43 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des Produits du tabac représente approximativement 87 p.c., celle des Filés et tissus de coton, 69 p.c. Confection pour femmes, 68 p.c., Chaussures en cuir, 60 p.c. et Matériel roulant de chemin de fer, 47 p.c. du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent premières avec \$184,536,427. Parmi les autres groupes importants, mentionnons: "Produits végétaux" \$181,016,203; "Bois et papier" \$172,740,836; "Métaux non ferreux" \$114,110,551; "Fer et ses produits", \$108,579,370; "Produits animaux", \$108,218,282; "Métalloïdes", \$58,883,761; "Produits chimiques", \$44,675,929; et "Industries diverses", \$10,362,240.

Figurent au tableau 5, les statistiques principales des quarante industries les plus importantes. L'industrie de la Pulpe et du papier, arrive encore bonne première avec \$88,-990,115 en valeur de production. Les autres industries se classent dans l'ordre suivant: Réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux, \$78,954,445; Filés de coton et cotonnades, \$39,-568,088; Tabac, cigares et cigarettes \$39,156,515, Confection pour femmes, \$39,113,490 et Matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$37,874,224, etc.

Le tableau 6 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 4.

Le tableau 7 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$474,534,092 se place bonne première avec près de 48 p.c. du grand total.

Les tableaux 8 et 9 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 10. Sur un grand total de \$1,146,235,084, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$731,183,518, valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$227,567,574, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$187,483,992.

L'outillage de force motrice et la consommation de combustible et d'électricité dans les industries manufacturières du Québec font l'objet des tableaux 12 et 11.
