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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE
OF QUEBEC, 1939

The value of manufactured products which totalled \$1,045,757,585 in 1939 represents an increase of 6.4 p.c. as compared with the previous year. Reports were received from 8,373 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,182,538,441. The number of persons employed totalled 220,321 and the salaries and wages paid \$223,757,757, while the cost of materials and the value added by manufacture were \$536,823,039 and \$470,385,279 respectively.

The upward climb in manufacturing production begun in the summer of 1933 was greatly accelerated in 1937. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of 21.2 p.c. in the gross value of production, 18.1 p.c. in the value added by manufacture, 12.4 p.c. in the number of persons employed and 19.0 p.c. in the salaries and wages paid. In many respects 1937 was a record year. The number of employees at 219,033 represented then an all-time high for the manufacturing industries of Quebec, exceeding by 12,959 the previous high record attained in 1929. Salary and wage payments, although substantially higher than for a number of years, were still, however, about 3 p.c. below the 1929 level. The physical volume of production was also the highest on record. It is estimated that the volume in 1937 was about 14 p.c. greater than in 1929. However, due to a drop of 13.4 p.c. in the prices of fully and chiefly manufactured products, the gross value of production was still 5.4 p.c. below the 1929 figures.

In 1938 a minor recession was experienced. There was a decrease of 2.1 p.c. in the number of persons employed, 1.7 p.c. in the salaries and wages paid, 3.9 p.c. in the net value and 6.0 p.c. in the gross value of products made. The advance in production in 1939 was greater than the decline of the previous year. Compared with 1938 there were increases of 2.7 p.c. in the number of persons employed, 4.8 p.c. in the amount of salaries and wages paid, 6.4 p.c. in the gross value of production and 9.8 p.c. in the value added by manufacture. The number of persons employed in 1939 was the highest on record, exceeding the previous high reported in 1937. The amount of salaries and wages paid, although exceeding the 1937 payments, was still about \$1,000,000 below the previous high record of 1929.

Quebec with about 30 p.c. of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 10 p.c. of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 50 p.c. of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products forms approximately 85 p.c., cotton yarn and cloth 70 p.c., women's factory clothing 67 p.c., leather boots and shoes 60 p.c., men's factory clothing 56 p.c., and railway rolling stock 42 p.c. of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

STATISTIQUE MANUFACTURIERE DE LA PROVINCE
DE QUEBEC, 1939

Le chiffre de production des industries manufacturières de cette province qui s'élève à \$1,045,757,585 en 1939 représente une augmentation de 6.4 p.c. comparativement à l'année précédente. Il y a 8,373 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations. Les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,182,538,441, les effectifs à 220,321 et les salaires et gages à \$223,757,757 tandis que le coût des matières employées et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation s'élèvent à \$536,823,039 et \$470,385,279 respectivement.

L'essor de la production manufacturière commencé à l'été de 1933 s'est grandement accéléré en 1937. Comparativement à l'année précédente on enregistre une augmentation de 21.2 p.c. dans la valeur brute des produits, 18.1 p.c. dans la valeur ajoutée par la transformation, 12.4 p.c. dans le nombre d'employés et 19.0 p.c. dans les sommes payées en rémunération au personnel. A plusieurs points de vue, 1937 fut une année sommet. Les effectifs de 219,033 atteignirent alors un niveau sans précédent dans l'histoire de la production manufacturière de la province de Québec, dépassant par 12,959 le record de 1929. Les salaires et gages bien que sensiblement plus élevés depuis un certain nombre d'années furent encore de 3 p.c. inférieurs à ceux de 1929. Le volume physique de la production atteint aussi un niveau sans précédent. On estime qu'il était en 1937 de 14 p.c. au-dessus de celui de 1929. Toutefois, en raison d'une baisse de prix de 13.4 p.c. dans les produits entièrement ou partiellement ouvrés, la valeur brute de la production était encore de 5.4 p.c. inférieure à celle de 1929.

En 1938 une légère diminution se fait sentir comme suit: 2.1 p.c. dans le nombre de employés, 1.7 p.c. dans les salaires et gages, 3.9 p.c. dans la valeur nette des produits et 6.0 p.c. dans la valeur brute. L'augmentation dans la production en 1939 est plus grande que la diminution de l'année précédente. Comparativement à 1938, il y eut augmentation de 2.7 p.c. dans le nombres d'employés, 4.8 p.c. dans les salaires et gages, 6.4 p.c. dans la valeur brute des produits et 9.8 p.c. dans la valeur ajoutée par la transformation. Le nombre de personnes employées en 1939 a atteint un nouveau sommet dépassant même celui de 1937. Les salaires et gages, quoique plus élevés qu'en 1937, furent quand même plus bas que ceux de l'année record 1929 d'environ \$1,000,000.

Le Québec avec environ 30 p.c. de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 10 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 50 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des Produits du tabac représente approximativement 85 p.c., celle des Filés et tissus de coton, 70 p.c. Confection pour femmes 67 p.c., Chaussures en cuir, 60 p.c., Confection pour hommes, 56 p.c. et Matériel roulant de chemin de fer, 42 p.c. du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur des ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries again headed the list with an output valued at \$207,197,096. Other major groups in order of their importance are: Wood and paper products \$189,344,198, vegetable products \$184,561,832, non-ferrous metal products \$122,587,370, animal products \$118,345,092, iron and its products \$100,567,223, non-metallic mineral products \$62,400,551, chemicals \$48,203,401 and miscellaneous industries \$11,650,522.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in Table 5. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$103,564,981. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining \$86,005,322, cotton yarn and cloth \$49,176,421, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$39,986,847, women's factory clothing \$39,782,799, men's factory clothing \$39,584,165, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in Table 4 are reviewed in Table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a production of \$483,246,583 leads by a very wide margin accounting for about 46 p.c. of the entire output of the province.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups for 1939 are shown in Table 10. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,182,538,441, \$727,372,170 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$241,765,103, while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$213,401,168.

Statistics of fuel and electricity consumed are given in Table 12 and power equipment in Table 11.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent premières avec \$207,197,096. Parmi les autres groupes importants mentionnés: "bois et papier" \$189,344,198; "produits végétaux" \$184,561,832; "métaux non ferreux" \$122,587,370; "produits animaux" \$118,345,092, "fer et ses produits" \$100,567,223; "métalloïdes" \$62,400,551; "produits chimiques" \$48,203,401 et "industries diverses" \$11,650,522.

Figurent au tableau 5, les statistiques principales des 40 industries les plus importantes. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier arrive encore bonne première avec \$103,564,981. Les autres industries se classent dans l'ordre suivant: réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux \$86,005,322, filés de coton et cotonnades \$49,176,421, tabacs, cigares et cigarettes \$39,986,847, confection pour femmes \$39,782,799, confection pour hommes \$39,584,165, etc.

Le tableau 6 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 4.

Le tableau 7 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$483,246,583 se place bonne première avec près de 46 p.c. du grand total.

Les tableaux 8 et 9 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 10. Sur un grand total de \$1,182,538,441, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$727,372,170, valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$241,765,103, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$213,401,168.

La consommation du combustible et de l'électricité et l'entretien de force motrice font l'objet des tableaux 11 et 12.
