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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC, 1940

Manufacturing production in the Province of Quebec was greatly accelerated by the demands created by the present war. Compared with the previous year there were increases of 14.6 per cent in the number of persons employed, 24.1 per cent in the salaries and wages paid, and 29.8 per cent in the gross value of production. Of the increase of \$311,618,191 in the gross value of production 23 per cent was contributed by the textiles and textile products group, 22 per cent by the iron and its products group, 21 per cent by the wood and paper products group, 13 per cent by the non-ferrous metal products group, 8 per cent by the vegetable products group, and the balance by the other groups, in the order named: chemicals and allied products, animal products, non-metallic mineral products and miscellaneous industries.

In 1940 reports were received from 8,381 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,345,927,911. The number of persons employed totalled 252,492 and the salaries and wages paid \$277,539,876, while the cost of materials used and value added by manufacture were \$713,132,575 and \$395,552,909 respectively. The value of products made totalled \$1,357,375,776.

Quebec with about 30 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 11 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 51 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products forms approximately 87 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 70 per cent, women's factory clothing, 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 60 per cent, men's factory clothing 55 per cent, and railway rolling stock 41 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries again headed the list with an output valued at \$277,541,629. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: wood and paper products \$254,958,817, vegetable products \$208,190,936, iron and its products \$169,716,578, non-ferrous metal products \$162,575,254, animal products \$135,811,678, non-metallic mineral products \$68,151,940, chemicals and allied products \$66,307,107 and miscellaneous industries \$14,121,837.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in Table 5. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again heads the list with an output valued at \$151,264,649. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining \$105,454,494, cotton yarn and cloth \$72,240,278, men's factory clothing \$55,-391,436, women's factory clothing \$46,519,869, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$42,504,146, slaughtering and meat packing \$41,439,495, railway rolling-stock \$39,533,884, butter and cheese \$34,591,551, petroleum products \$32,268,-186, etc.

LES INDUSTRIES MANUFACTURIERES DE LA PROVINCE DE QUEBEC,  
1940

La production manufacturière de la province de Québec s'est grandement accélérée à cause de la demande créée par la guerre. Comparativement à l'année précédente il y eut augmentation de 14.6 pour cent dans le nombre des employés, 24.1 pour cent dans les salaires et gages et 29.8 pour cent dans la valeur brute de la production. 23 pour cent de l'augmentation de \$311,618,191 dans la valeur brute de la production est attribué aux industries textiles, 22 pour cent au groupe du fer et de ses produits, 21 pour cent aux produits du bois et du papier, 13 pour cent aux métaux non-ferreux, 8 pour cent aux produits végétaux et la balance aux groupes dans l'ordre nommé: produits chimiques, produits animaux, métalloïdes et industries diverses.

En 1940 il y a 8,381 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations. Les capitaux engagés s'élèvent à \$1,345,927,911, les effectifs à 252,492 et les salaires et gages à \$277,539,876 tandis que le coût des matières employées et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation s'élèvent à \$713,132,575 et \$395,552,909 respectivement. La valeur des produits fabriqués est de \$1,357,375,776.

Le Québec avec environ 30 pour cent de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 11 pour cent de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 51 pour cent de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 87 pour cent, celle des filés et tissus de coton, 70 pour cent, confection pour femmes 68 pour cent, chaussures en cuir, 60 pour cent, confection pour hommes, 55 pour cent et matériel roulant de chemin de fer, 41 pour cent du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec \$277,541,629. Les autres groupes se classent comme suit: bois et papier \$254,958,817, produits végétaux \$208,-190,936, fer et ses produits \$169,716,578, métaux non-ferreux \$162,575,254, produits animaux \$135,811,678, métalloïdes \$68,151,940, produits chimiques \$66,307,107, et industries diverses \$14,121,837.

Figurent au tableau 5, les statistiques principales des quarante industries les plus importantes. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier arrive encore première avec \$151,264,649 en valeur brute de production. Les autres industries principales se classent dans l'ordre suivant: réduction et affinage des métaux non-ferreux \$105,454,494, filés et tissus de coton \$72,240,278, confection pour hommes \$55,-391,436, tabac, cigares et cigarettes \$42,504,146, abattoirs et salaisons \$41,439,495, matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$39,533,884, beurre et fromage \$34,591,551, produits du pétrole \$32,268,-186, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in Table 4 are reviewed in Table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a production of \$604,806,394 leads by a very wide margin accounting for about 44 per cent of the entire output of the province.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups for 1940 are shown in Table 10. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,345,927,911, \$763,696,330 represents the investment in land, buildings, machinery and tools. Inventory values of raw materials and finished products on hand amounted to \$312,729,418, while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges totalled \$269,302,163.

Statistics of fuel and electricity consumed are given in Table 12 and power equipment in Table 11.

Le tableau 6 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les catégories figurant dans le tableau 4.

Le tableau 7 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal, avec un chiffre de production de \$604,806,394 se place bonne première avec près de 44 pour cent du grand total.

Les tableaux 8 et 9 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec.

Les données relatives aux capitaux engagés des divers groupes figurent dans le tableau 10. Sur un grand total de \$1,345,927,911, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$763,696,330, valeur inventoriée des produits ouvrés, et des matières premières, \$312,729,418, capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation), \$269,502,163.

La consommation du combustible et de l'électricité et l'outillage de force motrice font l'objet des tableaux 11 et 12.
