QUÉBEC, 1941.

Manufacturing production in the Province of Quebec was greatly accelerated in 1941 as a result of war production. Compared with the previous year there were increases of 29.7 per cent in the number of persons employed, 41.8 per cent in the salaries and wages paid, and 35.6 per cent in the gross value of production. Of the increase of \$483,712,747 in the gross value of production 25 per cent was contributed by the iron and its products group, 17 per cent by textiles and textile products, 17 per cent by non-ferrous metal products, 11 per cent by chemicals, 9 per cent by wood and paper products, 8 per cent by vegetable products, 7 per cent by animal products, 5 per cent by non-metallic mineral products, and 1 per cent by miscellaneous industries.

La production manufacturière de la province de Québec s'est grandement accélérée en 1941, à cause de la production de guerre. Comparativement à l'année précédente il y eut une augmentation de 29.7 pour cent dans le nombre des employés, 41.8 pour cent dans les salaires et gages et 35.6 pour cent dans la valeur brute de la production. De l'augmentation de \$483,712,747 dans la valeur brute de la production 25 pour cent est attribué aux industries comprises dans le groupe fer et ses produits, 17 pour cent aux textiles, 17 pour cent aux métaux non-ferreux, 11 pour cent aux produits chimiques, 9 pour cent aux produits du bois et du papier, 8 pour cent aux produits végétaux, 7 pour cent aux produits animaux, 5 pour cent aux métalloses et 1 pour cent aux industries diverses.

In 1941 reports were received from 8,711 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,700,527,405. The number of persons employed totalled 327,591 and the salaries and wages paid \$393,819,671, while the cost of materials used and value added by manufacture were \$961,162,209 and \$815,086,832 respectively. The value of products made totalled \$1,841,088,523.

En 1941 il y a 8,711 établissements qui ont fourni des déclarations. Les capitaux engagés s'élevaient à \$1,700,527,405, les effectifs à 327,591 et les salaires et gages à \$393,819,671 tandis que le coût des matières employées et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation est de \$961,162,209 et \$815,086,832 respectivement. La valeur totale des produits s'élève à \$1,841,088,523.

Quebec with about 30 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is the dominant industry. In addition to supplying about 9 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, it furnishes about 50 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products forms approximately 87 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 72 per cent, women's factory clothing, 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 61 per cent, men's factory clothing 58 per cent, and railway rolling stock 47 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

Le Québec avec environ 30 pour cent de la production totale du Canada, se classe au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. La plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier qui constitue environ 9 pour cent de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 50 pour cent de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 87 pour cent, celle des filés et tissus de coton, 72 pour cent, confection pour femmes 68 pour cent, chaussures en cuir, 61 pour cent, confection pour hommes, 58 pour cent et matériel roulant de chemin de fer, 47 pour cent du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province dans le domaine industriel est due à l'ampleur de ses industries, plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

From the point of view of gross value of products, the textile industries again headed the list with an output valued at \$359,323,559. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: wood and paper products \$297,594,135, iron and its products \$291,673,076, vegetable products \$247,411,759, non-ferrous metal products \$243,712,826, animal products \$172,085,239, chemical products \$120,569,492, non-metallic mineral products \$90,549,465 and miscellaneous industries \$18,168,972.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les industries textiles arrivent encore premières avec \$359,323,559. Les autres groupes se classent comme suit: bois et papier \$297,594,135, fer et ses produits \$291,673,076, produits végétaux \$247,411,759, produits des métaux non-ferreux \$243,712,826, produits animaux \$172,085,239, produits chimiques \$120,569,492, métallose \$90,549,465, et industries diverses \$18,168,972.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in Table 5. In value of production the pulp and paper industry again headed the list with an output valued at \$166,578,687. Other leading industries are: non-ferrous metal smelting and refining \$150,281,059, cotton yarn and cloth \$92,823,043, men's factory clothing \$67,-353,152, women's factory clothing \$64,366,368, miscellaneous chemical products \$60,140,852, railway-rolling stock \$55,346,274, slaughtering and meat packing \$49,764,770, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$46,918,972, butter and cheese \$46,-175,003, petroleum products \$44,455,163, electrical apparatus and supplies \$40,600,754, etc.

Figurent au Tableau 5 les statistiques principales des quarante industries les plus importantes. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier arrive encore première avec \$166,578,687. Viennent ensuite dans l'ordre nommé: réduction et affinage des métaux non-ferreux \$150,281,059, filés et tissus de coton \$92,823,043, confection pour hommes \$67,353,152, confection pour femmes \$64,366,368, produits chimiques divers \$60,140,852, matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$55,346,274, abattoirs et salaisons \$49,764,-770, tabac, cigares et cigarettes \$46,918,972, beurre et fromage \$46,175,003, produits du pétrole \$44,455,163, appareils et fournitures électriques \$40,600,754, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in Table 4 are reviewed in Table 6.

Le Tableau 6 donne les principales statistiques des industries qui constituent les groupes figurant dans le Tableau 4.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the Province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$803,-685,931 leads by a wide margin, accounting for about 44 per cent of the entire output of the province. Other important cities in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Shawinigan Falls, Quebec, Three Rivers, Lachine, Sherbrooke, Valleyfield, Drummondville, and Hull.

Le Tableau 7 contient les principales statistiques des cités et villes de Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal avec un chiffre de production \$803,685,931 se place bonne première avec environ 44 pour cent du grand total. Viennent ensuite par ordre d'importance: Montréal Est, Shawinigan Falls, Québec, Trois-Rivières, Lachine, Sherbrooke, Valleyfield, Drummondville, et Hull.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec.

Les Tableaux 8 et 9 contiennent les statistiques des industries établies à Montréal et Québec.

Details of capital investment by industrial groups for 1941 are shown in Table 10. Of the total capital invested amounting to \$1,700,527,405, \$881,762,365 represents the investment in land, building, machines and tools. Inventory values of raw materials on hand amounted to \$317,877,334, and inventories of finished products totalled \$107,476,405, while operating capital, consisting of cash, bills and accounts receivable and deferred charges amounted to \$393,411,301.

Les détails des capitaux engagés dans les différents groupes figurent au Table 10. Sur un grand total de \$1,700,527,405, les terrains, les bâtiments, les machines et l'outillage y sont pour \$881,762,365, valeur inventoriée du matériel en main \$317,877,334, valeur des produits ouverts \$107,476,405, tandis que le capital de roulement (caisse, effets à recevoir, frais payés par anticipation) s'élève à \$393,411,301.

Statistics of fuel and electricity consumed are given in Table 12 and details of power equipment in Table 11.
