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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC,
1942.

Under the impetus of war production, the manufacturing industries of the Province of Quebec continued to expand in 1942. Compared with the previous year there were increases of 21.8 per cent in the number of persons employed, 36.2 per cent in the salaries and wages paid, and 26.7 per cent in the gross value of production. Of the increase of \$492,214,489 in the gross value of production 31.2 per cent was contributed by the iron and its products group, 19.9 per cent by chemicals, 18.7 per cent by non-ferrous metals, 14.5 per cent by textiles, 6.7 per cent by animal products, 5.0 per cent by wood and paper products, 3.5 per cent by vegetable products, and .5 per cent by the miscellaneous industries group. The output of non-metallic mineral products group which includes many industries producing construction materials declined by \$3,251,079.

In 1942 reports were received from 9,342 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$1,883,353,668. The number of persons employed totalled 399,017, and the salaries and wages paid \$536,329,170, while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$1,193,445,432 and \$1,059,873,943 respectively. The selling value at the factory of the products made totalled \$2,333,303,012.

Quebec with about 31 per cent of the Dominion output is the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is normally the dominant industry but in 1942 it was displaced by the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining industry for the premier position. In addition to supplying about 7 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures, the pulp and paper industry furnishes about 50 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products forms approximately 88 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 76 per cent, women's factory clothing 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 63 per cent, men's factory clothing 56 per cent, railway rolling-stock 52 per cent, and non-ferrous metal smelting and refining 44 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. The province of Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the diversification of her industrial activities.

LES INDUSTRIES MANUFACTURIÈRES DE LA PROVINCE DE
QUEBEC, 1942.

Sous la poussée de la production de guerre, les industries manufacturières de la province de Québec ont continué de progresser en 1942. Comparativement à l'année précédente, il y eut augmentations de 21.8 p.c. dans le nombre de personnes employées, 36.2 p.c. dans les salaires et gages et 26.7 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production. De l'augmentation de \$492,214,489 dans la valeur brute de production, 31.2 p.c. est attribué aux industries du fer et ses produits, 19.9 p.c. aux produits chimiques, 18.7 p.c. aux métaux non-ferreux, 14.5 p.c. aux textiles, 6.7 p.c. aux produits animaux, 5.0 p.c. aux produits du bois et du papier, 3.5 p.c. aux produits végétaux et .5 p.c. aux industries diverses. La valeur de production dans le groupe des métalloïdes lequel comprend les matériaux de construction a diminué de \$3,251,079.

En 1942, il y a 9,342 établissements ayant des capitaux de \$1,883,353,668 qui nous ont fait rapport. Le nombre de personnes employées s'élève à 399,017, les salaires et gages à \$536,329,170, tandis que le coût des matières et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation s'élève à \$1,193,445,432 et \$1,059,873,943, respectivement. Le prix de vente à la fabrique des produits fabriqués s'élève à \$2,333,303,012.

Le Québec avec environ 31 p.c. de la production totale du Canada se place en deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. En temps normal, la plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier, mais en 1942 cette industrie fut dépassée par celle de la réduction et de l'affinage des métaux non-ferreux. Cependant, l'industrie de la pulpe et du papier constitue environ 7 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 50 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 88 p.c., celle des filés et tissus de coton 76 p.c., confection pour femmes 68 p.c., chaussures en cuir 63 p.c., confection pour hommes 56 p.c., matériel roulant de chemin de fer 52 p.c. et affinage et réduction des métaux non-ferreux 44 p.c. du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

From the point of view of gross value of products the iron and its products group headed the list in 1942 with an output valued at \$446,133,739, displacing the textile group which normally comes first. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: textiles and textile products \$431,293,769, non-ferrous metal products \$336,491,281, wood and paper products \$322,394,227, vegetable products \$264,830,026, chemicals and allied products \$219,104,671, animal products \$205,404,264, non-metallic mineral products \$87,298,386, and miscellaneous industries \$20,352,649.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in Table 5. In value of production the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining industry headed the list with an output valued at \$196,436,575, displacing from the premier position the pulp and paper industry which came second with a value of production of \$168,294,770. Other leading industries are: miscellaneous chemical products \$142,859,296, cotton yarn and cloth \$107,973,989, men's factory clothing \$83,967,087, railway rolling-stock \$81,809,756, women's factory clothing \$78,907,824, shipbuilding and repairs \$72,386,431, brass and copper products \$66,274,520, electrical apparatus and supplies \$60,532,458, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in Table 4 are reviewed in Table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the Province of Quebec with three or more establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$976,767,738 leads by a wide margin, accounting for about 42 per cent of the entire output of the province. Other important cities in 1942 in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Quebec, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Three Rivers, Sherbrooke, St. Laurent, Hull, St. Hyacinthe, Granby and Drummondville.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec. Details of capital investment are given in table 10, while tables 11 and 12 give details of power equipment and fuel and electricity used.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les produits du fer et de l'acier arrivent premiers en 1942 avec une valeur de \$446,133,739 dépassant le groupe textile qui normalement vient au premier rang. Les autres groupes se classent comme suit: textiles \$431,293,769, produits des métaux non-ferreux \$336,491,281, produits du bois et du papier \$322,394,227, produits végétaux \$264,830,026, produits chimiques \$219,104,671, produits animaux \$205,404,264, métalloïdes \$87,298,386 et industries diverses, \$20,352,649.

Les statistiques des quarante industries principales figurent au tableau 5. L'affinage et la réduction des métaux non-ferreux constituent l'industrie la plus importante en ce qui concerne la valeur de la production qui s'élève à \$196,436,575. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier (\$168,294,770) vient en second lieu. Les autres principales industries sont: divers produits chimiques \$142,859,296, filés et tissus de coton \$107,973,989, confection pour hommes \$83,967,087, matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$81,809,756, confection pour femmes \$78,907,824, chantiers maritimes \$72,386,431, produits du cuivre et du laiton \$66,274,520, appareils et fournitures électriques \$60,532,458, etc.

Les statistiques principales couvrant les industries comprises dans les groupes figurant au tableau 4 sont analysées au tableau 6.

Le tableau 7 contient les statistiques des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal avec un chiffre de production de \$976,767,738 se place bonne première avec environ 42 p.c. du grand total. Viennent ensuite: Montréal-Est, Québec, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Trois-Rivières, Sherbrooke, St-Laurent, Hull, St-Hyacinthe, Granby et Drummondville.

Les statistiques des villes de Montréal et de Québec sont données aux tableaux 8 et 9, tandis que les tableaux 10, 11 et 12 contiennent les détails de la force motrice, du combustible et de l'électricité employée.
