INDUSTRIES MANUFACTURIÈRES DE LA PROVINCE DE  
QUÉBEC, 1943.

Under the continued impetus of war production, the manufacturing industries of the Province of Québec expanded their output during 1943. Compared with the previous year there were increases of 9.6 per cent in the number of persons employed, 22.7 per cent in the salaries and wages paid, and 22.2 per cent in the gross value of production. Of the increase of \$518,888,841 in the gross value of production 43.7 per cent was contributed by the iron and its products group, 29.3 per cent by chemicals, 14.1 per cent by non-ferrous metal products, 4.2 per cent by vegetable products, 2.9 per cent by animal products, 2.8 per cent by wood and paper products, 2.7 per cent by non-metallic mineral products, and .3 per cent by the miscellaneous industries group. The value of textiles and textile products declined by \$2,553,278 or .6 per cent.

Sous la poussée de la production de guerre, les industries manufacturières de la Province de Québec ont continué de progresser en 1943. Comparativement à l'année précédente il y eut augmentation de 9.6 p.c. dans le nombre de personnes employées, 22.7 p.c. dans les salaires et gages, et 22.2 p.c. dans la valeur brute de la production. De l'augmentation de \$518,888,841 dans la valeur brute de production 43.7 p.c. est attribué à l'industrie du fer et ses produits, 29.3 p.c. aux produits chimiques, 14.1 p.c. aux métaux non-ferreux, 4.2 p.c. aux produits végétaux, 2.9 p.c. aux produits animaux, 2.8 p.c. aux produits du bois et du papier, 2.7 p.c. aux métalloïdes, et .3 p.c. au groupe des industries diverses. La valeur de production dans les industries textiles est diminuée de \$2,553,278 ou .6 p.c.

In 1943 reports were received from 9,372 manufacturing establishments with a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$2,230,620,386. The number of persons employed totalled 437,247, and the salaries and wages paid \$658,323,620, while the cost of materials used and the value added by manufacture were \$1,483,627,797 and \$1,280,097,615 respectively. The selling value at the factory of the products made totalled \$2,852,191,853.

En 1943 il y a 9,372 établissements ayant des capitaux de \$2,230,620,386 qui nous ont fait rapport. Le nombre de personnes employées s'élève à 437,247 et les salaires et gages à \$658,323,620, tandis que le coût des matières et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation s'élèvent à \$1,483,627,797 et \$1,280,097,615, respectivement. Le prix de vente à la fabrique des produits fabriqués s'élève à \$2,852,191,853.

Québec with about 33 per cent of the Dominion output in 1943 was the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper is normally the dominant industry, but since 1942 was displaced by the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining industry for the premier position. In addition to supplying about 6 per cent of the gross value of Québec manufactures, the pulp and paper industry furnished about 48 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products formed approximately 88 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 75 per cent, women's factory clothing 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 65 per cent, men's factory clothing 57 per cent, railway rolling-stock 54 per cent, and non-ferrous metal smelting and refining 51 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. Québec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province rather on account of her large individual industries than because of the great diversification of her industrial activities.

Le Québec avec environ 33 p.c. de la production totale du Canada se place en deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes, en 1943. En temps normal, la plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier mais en 1943 cette industrie fut dépassée par celle de la réduction et de l'affinage des métaux non-ferreux. Cependant, l'industrie de la pulpe et du papier constitue environ 6 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province et 48 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 88 p.c., celle des filés et tissus de coton 75 p.c., confection pour femmes 68 p.c., chaussures en cuir 65 p.c., confection pour hommes 57 p.c., matériel roulant de chemin de fer 54 p.c. et affinage et réduction des métaux non-ferreux 51 p.c. du total de ces produits pour tout le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

From the standpoint of gross value of production the iron and its products group again headed the list in 1943 with an output valued at \$674,027,880, displacing the textile group which normally

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les produits du fer et de l'acier arrivent encore au premier rang en 1943 avec une valeur de \$674,027,880 dépassant le groupe textile qui normale-



comes first. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: textiles and textile products \$428,740,491, non-ferrous metal products \$410,157,670, chemicals and allied products \$371,789,166, wood and paper products \$337,206,122, vegetable products \$286,491,549, animal products \$220,610,793, non-metallic mineral products \$101,583,384, and miscellaneous industries \$21,784,798.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in table 5. In value of production the miscellaneous chemical products industry headed the list with an output valued at \$277,993,561, displacing both the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining and the pulp and paper industries which ranked second and third with an output valued at \$259,643,014 and \$167,460,120 respectively. Other leading industries are: miscellaneous iron and steel products \$161,748,317, shipbuilding and repairs \$130,208,952, aircraft \$95,631,112, cotton yarn and cloth \$95,568,886, railway rolling stock \$86,274,059, men's factory clothing \$85,179,641, women's factory clothing \$83,076,981, electrical apparatus and supplies \$73,178,995, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in Table 4 are reviewed in Table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the Province of Quebec for which statistics can be shown without disclosing the operations of individual establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$1,184,114,458 leads by a wide margin, accounting for about 42 per cent of the entire output of the Province. Other important cities in 1943 in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Quebec, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Three Rivers, Sherbrooke, St. Laurent, Longueuil, etc. Arvida and St. Therese are also important manufacturing centres, statistics for these cannot, however, be published.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec. Details of capital investment are given in table 10, while tables 11 and 12 give details of power equipment and the cost of fuel and electricity used.

Les statistiques des quarante industries principales figurent au tableau 5. L'industrie des produits chimiques divers est la plus importante en ce qui concerne la valeur de la production, (\$277,993,561) dépassant l'affinage et la réduction des métaux non-ferreux ainsi que la pulpe et le papier qui ont une production de \$259,643,014 et \$167,460,120, respectivement. Les autres principales industries sont: produits divers du fer et de l'acier, \$161,748,317, constructions navales, \$130,208,952, aéroplanes, \$95,631,112, filés et tissus de coton, \$95,568,886, matériel roulant de chemin de fer, \$86,274,059, confection pour hommes, \$85,179,641, confection pour femmes, \$83,076,981, appareils et fournitures électriques, \$73,178,995, etc.

Les statistiques principales couvrant les industries comprises dans les groupes figurant au tableau 4 sont analysées au tableau 6.

Le tableau 7 contient les statistiques principales des cités et villes du Québec dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal avec un chiffre de production de \$1,184,114,458 se place bonne première avec environ 42 p.c. du grand total de la production de la province. Les autres grandes villes dans l'ordre de leur importance sont: Montréal-est, Québec, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Trois-Rivières, Sherbrooke, St. Laurent, Longueuil, etc. Les statistiques pour Arvida et Ste-Thérèse qui sont aussi d'importants centres manufacturiers ne peuvent être publiées.

Aux tableaux 8 et 9 figurent les statistiques principales des villes de Montréal et de Québec tandis que les tableaux 10, 11 et 12 contiennent les détails du capital, de la force motrice, du combustible et de l'électricité.
