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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC,  
1944.

Under the continued impetus of war production the manufacturing industries of the Province of Quebec operated at a high level of production during 1944, although at a slightly reduced scale. Compared with the previous year there was a decrease of 13,132 or 3.0 per cent in the number of persons employed, while the salaries and wages paid and the gross value of production were both up by 1.5 and 2.7 per cent respectively. The chemical and allied products group reported the greatest decline in production, as measured by the number of persons employed, with a drop of 7,039 persons. Employment in the iron and its products group declined by 5,985, non-ferrous metal products 3,421, and textiles and textile products 2,755. The wood and paper, vegetable and animal products groups were on the other hand more active as is indicated by the increases in employment of 3,200, 2,265 and 738 respectively. There were only slight changes in employment in the non-metallic and miscellaneous products groups.

In 1944 reports were received from 9,657 establishments. The number of persons employed totalled 424,115, and the salaries and wages paid \$668,156,053, while the cost of materials used and value added by manufacture were \$1,494,253,053 and \$1,350,519,134 respectively. The selling value at the factory of the products made totalled \$2,929,685,183.

Quebec with about 32 per cent of the Dominion output in 1944 was the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper normally constitutes the dominant industry, but in 1943 and 1944 was displaced from the premier position by the Miscellaneous chemical products industry and Non-ferrous metal smelting and refining. In addition to accounting for about 6 per cent of gross value of Quebec manufactures in 1944, the pulp and paper industry furnished about 50 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products totalled approximately 89 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 75 per cent, women's factory clothing 67 per cent, leather boots and shoes 65 per cent, men's factory clothing 58 per cent, railway rolling stock 53 per cent, and non-ferrous metal smelting and refining 51 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province by reason of her large individual industries and not so much on account of the great diversification of her industrial activity.

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INDUSTRIES MANUFACTURIERES DE LA PROVINCE DE  
QUEBEC, 1944.

Sous la poussée continue de la production de guerre, les industries manufacturières de la province de Québec ont continué de fonctionner à un rythme très élevé, quoique légèrement ralenti, en 1944. Comparativement à l'année précédente, il y eut diminution de 13,132 ou 3.0 p.c. dans le nombre de personnes employées tandis que les salaires et gages et la valeur brute de la production ont augmenté de 1.5 et de 2.7 p.c., respectivement. C'est dans le groupe des produits chimiques que se voit la plus grande diminution de production telle que mesurée par le nombre de personnes employées qui tombe de 7,039. Les effectifs dans le groupe du fer et de l'acier ont diminué de 5,985, dans les produits des métaux non ferreux de 3,421, dans les produits textiles, de 2,755. Par ailleurs, les groupes des produits du bois et du papier, des produits végétaux, des produits animaux furent plus actifs et ont constitué des augmentations de 3,200, 2,265 et 738 respectivement dans le nombre des employés. Il n'y a pas eu de changement notable dans l'emploiement en ce qui concerne les "Métalloïdes" et les "Produits divers".

En 1944, il y a 9,657 établissements qui nous ont fait rapport. Le nombre de personnes employées s'élève à 424,115, les salaires et gages à \$668,156,- 053 tandis que le coût des matières et la valeur ajoutée par la transformation s'élèvent à \$1,494,253,053 et \$1,350,519,134 respectivement. Le prix de vente, à la fabrique, des produits manufacturés s'élève à \$2,929,685,183.

Le Québec avec environ 32 p.c. de la production totale du Canada se place au deuxième rang parmi les provinces canadiennes. En temps normal, la plus importante de ses industries est celle de la pulpe et du papier, mais depuis 1943 cette industrie fut dépassée par celles des produits chimiques divers et de la réduction et affinage des métaux non-ferreux. Cependant, l'industrie de la pulpe et du papier constitue environ 6 p.c. de la valeur brute de production de la province et 50 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 89 p.c., celle de filés et tissus de coton, 75 p.c., confection pour femmes, 67 p.c., chaussures en cuir 65 p.c., confection pour hommes 58 p.c., matériel roulant de chemin de fer 53 p.c. et réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux 51 p.c. du total de ces produits pour le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués.

From the standpoint of gross value of production the iron and its products group again headed the list with an output valued at \$648,480,258, displacing the textile group which normally ranks first. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: textiles and textile products \$430,934,363, non-ferrous metal products \$404,055,401 wood and paper products \$377,488,895, chemicals and allied products \$370,363,933, vegetable products \$321,557,994, animal products \$246,217,640, non-metallic mineral products \$106,527,256, and miscellaneous industries \$23,859,-443.

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries are reviewed in table 5. In gross value of production the miscellaneous chemical products industry headed the list with an output valued at \$272,682,164, displacing both the non-ferrous metal smelting and refining and pulp and paper industries which ranked second and third with an output valued at \$242,854,585 and \$186,918,517 respectively. Other leading industries are: aircraft \$160,736,338, shipbuilding and repairs \$109,558,276, miscellaneous iron and steel products \$101,226,254, electrical apparatus and supplies \$99,449,654, women's factory clothing \$89,797,503, railway rolling-stock \$88,-652,108, cotton yarn and cloth \$87,587,072, slaughtering and meat packing \$80,379,717, men's factory clothing \$80,170,220, etc.

The principal statistics of the individual industries which make up the groups shown in table 4 are reviewed in table 6.

Table 7 covers the principal statistics of all cities and towns in the Province of Quebec for which statistics can be shown without disclosing the operations of individual establishments. The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$1,-315,988,014 leads by a wide margin, accounting for about 42 per cent of the entire output of the province. Montreal also is the largest manufacturing centre in Canada. Other important cities in 1944 in the Province of Quebec in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Quebec, Shawinigan Falls, Longueuil, St. Laurent, Lachine, Three Rivers, Sherbrooke, etc. Arvida, Ste. Thérèse de Blainville and Noranda are also important manufacturing centres. Statistics for these cannot, however, be published.

Tables 8 and 9 give the principal statistics of the industries located in the cities of Montreal and Quebec. Details of capital investment are given in table 10, while tables 11 and 12 give details of power equipment and the cost of fuel and electricity used.

Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les produits du fer et de l'acier arrivent encore au premier rang avec une valeur de \$648,480,258, dépassant le groupe textile qui normalement arrivait premier. Les autres groupes se classent comme suit: textiles, \$430,934,363, produits des métaux non ferreux, \$404,055,401, produits du bois et du papier, \$377,488,895, produits chimiques, \$370,363,933, produits végétaux, \$321,557,994, produits animaux, \$246,217,640, métalloïdes, \$106,627,256 et industries diverses, \$23,859,443.

Les statistiques des quarante industries principales figurent au tableau 5. L'industrie des Produits chimiques divers est la plus importante en ce qui concerne la valeur de la production qui s'élève à \$272,-682,164 dépassant ainsi l'industrie de l'affinage et de la réduction des métaux non-ferreux et l'industrie de la pulpe et du papier qui tombent au deuxième et troisième rang avec une valeur de production de \$242,-854,585 et \$186,918,517 respectivement. Les autres principales industries sont: Aéroplanes, \$160,736,338, constructions navales, \$109,558,276, produits divers du fer et de l'acier, \$101,226,254, appareils et fournitures électriques, \$99,449,654, confection pour femmes \$89,797,503, matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$88,652,-108, filés et tissus de coton, \$87,587,072, abattoirs et salaisons, \$80,379,717, confection pour hommes \$80,170,-220, etc.

Les statistiques principales couvrant les industries comprises dans les groupes figurant au tableau 4 sont analysées au tableau 6.

Le tableau 7 contient les statistiques principales des cités et villes du Québec qui sont dotées de trois établissements ou plus. La cité de Montréal avec un chiffre de production de \$1,215,988,014 se place bonne première avec environ 42 pour cent du grand total de la production de la province et est, en même temps, le plus grand centre manufacturier du Canada. Les autres grandes villes dans l'ordre de leur importance sont: Montréal-est, Québec, Shawinigan Falls, Longueuil, St-Laurent, Lachine, Trois-Rivières, Sherbrooke, etc. Les statistiques pour Arvida, Ste-Thérèse de Blainville et Noranda qui sont aussi d'importants centres manufacturiers ne peuvent être publiées.

Aux tableaux 8 et 9 figurent les statistiques principales des villes de Montréal et Québec tandis que les tableaux 10, 11 et 12 contiennent les détails du capital, de la force motrice, du combustible et de l'électricité.
