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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC,
1945.

With the end of the war in 1945, manufacturing production in Quebec, as well as throughout the rest of Canada, dropped sharply. The production of war equipment was immediately curtailed and in many instances entirely discontinued. Many factories began to convert from war to peace-time production, while the production of many lines of consumers goods surged upwards. As a result of these changes, production in Quebec during 1945 which was valued at \$2,531,903,830 represented a drop of \$397,781,353 or 13.6 per cent as compared with the previous year. There was also a drop of 40,084 or 9.5 per cent in the number of persons employed and \$60,682,610 or 9.1 per cent in the amount of salaries and wages paid. As was to be expected, the iron and its products group reported the greatest decline in production, with a drop of 25,291 workers. Employment in the chemical industries also declined by 16,476 and in the non-ferrous metal group by 10,350. On the other hand, employment in industries producing consumers goods advanced. There was thus an increase of 3,644 in wood and paper products, 3,361 in textiles, 2,295 in animal products, 1,608 in vegetable products, 629 in miscellaneous industries and 496 in non-metallic mineral products.

In 1945 reports were received from 10,038 establishments operating in Quebec. Their combined output was valued at \$2,531,903,830. Employment was furnished to 384,031 persons who were paid \$607,473,443 in salaries and wages. The cost of materials used was valued at \$1,307,534,193, while the value added by manufacture amounted to \$1,149,390,919.

Quebec with about 31 per cent of the Dominion output in 1945 was the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper again occupied the premier position which was held during 1943 and 1944 by miscellaneous chemical products and non-ferrous metal smelting and refining. In addition to accounting for about 8 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures in 1945, the pulp and paper industry furnished about 50 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products totalled approximately 89 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 74 per cent, women's factory clothing 67 per cent, leather boots and shoes 66 per cent, men's factory clothing 60 per cent and railway rolling-stock 53 per cent of the Dominion totals of these products. Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province by reason of her large individual industries and not so much on account of a great diversification of manufacturing

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INDUSTRIES MANUFACTURIERES DE LA PROVINCE DE
QUEBEC, 1945.

Avec la fin de la guerre en 1945, la production manufacturière du Québec diminue brusquement, comme d'ailleurs celle de tout le Canada. La production du matériel de guerre est immédiatement restreinte et, dans plusieurs cas, cesse entièrement. Un grand nombre de manufactures ont commencé à se transformer en vue d'une production de temps de paix, tandis que la production de plusieurs articles de consommation augmente. En raison de ces changements, la production du Québec, évaluée à \$2,531,903,830 en 1945, représente une diminution de \$397,781,353 ou 13.6 pour cent sur l'année précédente. Il y a diminution de 40,084, ou 9.5 p.c., du nombre d'employés et de \$60,682,610 ou 9.1 p.c. du total des salaires et gages. Comme il fallait s'y attendre, le groupe du fer et de ses produits accuse la plus forte diminution de production et enregistre 25,291 travailleurs de moins. L'emploi diminue également dans les industries chimiques et dans les métaux non ferreux; le nombre d'employés est inférieur de 16,476 dans le premier cas et de 10,350, dans le second. D'autre part, l'emploi est plus élevé dans les industries produisant des articles de consommation. Ainsi il y a une augmentation de 3,644 dans le groupe des produits du bois et du papier; de 3,361, dans les produits textiles; de 2,295, dans les produits animaux; de 1,608, dans les produits végétaux; de 629, dans les industries diverses et de 496, dans les métallofides.

En 1945, il y a 10,038 établissements qui nous ont fait rapport. Leur valeur de production s'élève à \$2,531,903,830, le nombre de personnes employées à 384,031, les salaires et gages à \$607,473,443, le coût des matières à \$1,307,534,193, tandis que la valeur ajoutée par la transformation est de \$1,149,390,919.

Le Québec avec environ 31 p.c. de la production totale du Canada se place deuxième parmi les provinces canadiennes. L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier a repris le premier rang, déplaçant l'industrie des produits chimiques divers et la réduction et affinage des métaux non ferreux qui occupaient, respectivement, la première et la deuxième place en 1943 et 1944. Cette industrie constitue environ 6 p.c. de la valeur brute de la production de la province en 1945 et 50 p.c. de la production de la pulpe et du papier pour tout le Canada. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 89 p.c., celle des filés et tissus de coton 74 p.c., confection pour femmes 67 p.c., chaussures en cuir 66 p.c., confection pour hommes 60 p.c., matériel roulant de chemins de fer 53 p.c., du total de ces produits pour le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués. Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production,

From the standpoint of gross value of production the iron and its products group again headed the list with an output valued at \$489,010,-669, displacing the textile group which normally ranks first. Other major groups in the order of their importance are: textiles and textile products \$450,393,106, wood and paper products \$412,-696,856, vegetable products \$345,016,091, animal products \$261,891,709, non-ferrous metal products \$251,066,236, chemicals and allied products \$188,-403,106, non-metallic mineral products \$105,368,-067, and miscellaneous industries \$28,057,990.

The pulp and paper industry with an output valued at \$199,172,142 in 1945 once again occupied the premier position. Non-ferrous metal smelting and refining with an output of \$131,570,344 came second, followed by women's factory clothing with \$100,420,371, miscellaneous chemical products \$98,958,463, railway rolling-stock \$95,360,595, cotton yarn and cloth \$85,187,647, men's factory clothing \$83,252,216, aircraft \$77,090,671, slaughtering and meat packing \$75,983,490, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$73,166,256, electrical apparatus and supplies \$62,741,255, shipbuilding \$62,564,711, miscellaneous iron and steel products \$61,036,164, etc.

The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$1,144,175,108 in 1945 was the most important manufacturing centre and accounted for 45 per cent of the entire output of the province. Other leading cities in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Quebec, Thre Rivers, Longueuil, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Sherbrooke, Drummondville, etc. Arvida is also an important manufacturing centre. The statistics for it do not, however, appear in table 7 which gives the principal statistics of all cities and towns for which statistics can be shown without disclosing the operations of an individual establishment.

Les autres groupes se classent comme suit: textiles, \$450,393,106, bois et papier \$412,696,856, produits végétaux \$345,016,091, produits animaux \$261,891,709, métaux non ferreux \$251,066,236, produits chimiques \$188,403,-106, métallurgie \$105,368,067 et industries diverses \$28,057,990.

L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier avec une valeur de production de \$199,172,142 en 1945 occupe de nouveau le premier rang. L'affinage et la réduction des métaux non ferreux avec une valeur de \$131,570,344 se classe deuxième. Les autres principales industries sont: confection pour femmes \$100,420,371, produits chimiques divers \$98,958,463, matériel roulant de chemin de fer \$95,360,595, filés et tissus de coton \$85,187,-647, confection pour hommes \$83,252,216, aéroplanes \$77,090,671, abattoirs et salaisons \$75,983,-490, tabac, cigares et cigarettes \$73,166,256, appareils et fournitures électriques \$62,741,255, constructions navales \$62,564,711 et produits divers du fer et de l'acier \$61,036,164, etc.

La cité de Montréal avec un chiffre de production de \$1,144,175,108 en 1945 se place bonne première avec environ 45 p.c. du grand total de la production de la province. Les autres grandes villes dans l'ordre de l'importance sont: Montréal-est, Québec, Trois-Rivières, Longueuil, Shawinigan Falls, Lachine, Sherbrooke, Drummondville, etc. Les statistiques pour Arvida qui est aussi un important centre manufacturier ne sont pas publiées au tableau 7 car ce tableau ne donne que les statistiques des villes et villages pour lesquelles il est possible de les publier sans divulguer les opérations individuelles des établissements.
