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MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC,  
1946.

As was to be expected, the ending of the war in 1945 resulted in an immediate decline in the level of production in the Province of Quebec as well as throughout the rest of Canada. Although the production of consumers goods surged upward with the end of hostilities, the increase was not, however, of sufficient magnitude to offset the almost complete cessation of the manufacture of war equipment and materials. There was thus in 1945 a drop of 40,084 in the number of persons employed, \$60,682,610 in the salaries and wages paid, and \$201,128,215 in the net value of production. The decline continued throughout 1946 with the result that the number of persons employed declined by another 26,755, salaries and wages paid by \$41,487,338 and the net value of production by \$23,399,071. As was to be expected, the iron and its products group reported the greatest decline in production with a drop of 23,946, followed by chemicals and allied products with a drop of 16,074, non-ferrous metal products 649 and vegetable products 160. On the other hand, employment in the industries producing consumers goods advanced. There was an increase of 7,276 employees in the wood and paper products group, 3,174 in textiles, 2,186 in animal products, 1,280 in non-metallic mineral products and 158 in the miscellaneous industries group.

In 1946 reports were received from 10,818 establishments operating in Quebec. Their combined output was valued at \$2,497,971,521. Employment was furnished to 357,276 persons who were paid \$565,986,105 in salaries and wages. The materials used were valued at \$1,297,009,099, while the value added by manufacture amounted to \$1,125,991,848.

Quebec with about 31 per cent of the Dominion output in 1946 was the second largest manufacturing province. The production of pulp and paper again occupied the premier position which was held during 1943 and 1944 by miscellaneous chemical products and non-ferrous metal smelting and refining, respectively. In addition to accounting for about 11 per cent of the gross value of Quebec manufactures in 1946, the pulp and paper industry furnished about 50 per cent of the Dominion total for this industry. The value of tobacco products totalled approximately 89 per cent, cotton yarn and cloth 71 per cent, women's factory clothing 68 per cent, silk 68 per cent, leather boots and shoes 65 per cent, men's factory clothing 59 per cent, railway rolling-stock 54 per cent, fur goods 48 per cent, and hosiery and knitted goods 41 per cent of the Dominion totals of these industries. Quebec is thus an outstanding manufacturing province by reason of her large individual industries and not so much on account of a great diversification of

QUEBEC, 1946.

Comme il fallait s'y attendre, le niveau de la production dans la province de Québec, comme dans tout le reste du Canada, accuse une diminution immédiate à la fin de la guerre en 1945. Bien que la fin des hostilités ait donné un essor à la production d'articles de consommation, l'augmentation n'est cependant pas suffisante pour contre-balancer la cessation presque complète de la fabrication d'outillage et matériel de guerre. En conséquence, le nombre d'employés tombe de 40,084 en 1945, les salaires et gages, de \$60,682,610, et la valeur nette de la production, de \$201,128,215. La diminution s'est poursuivie en 1946 avec le résultat que le nombre d'employés tombe de nouveau de 26,755 en cette dernière année, les salaires et gages, de \$41,487,338, et la valeur nette de la production, de \$23,399,071. Comme il était aussi à prévoir, le groupe du fer et de ses produits accuse la plus forte diminution de production et une baisse de 23,946 employés. Il est suivi, dans l'ordre, des produits chimiques et leurs dérivés, des métaux non-ferreux et leurs produits et des substances végétales, dont les nombres d'employés tombent respectivement de 16,074, 649 et 160. Par ailleurs, l'emploi augmente dans les industries qui produisent des articles de consommation. Il y a augmentation de 7,276 employés dans le groupe des produits du bois et du papier, de 3,174 dans le groupe des textiles, de 2,186 dans les produits animaux, de 1,280 dans les métalloïdes et de 158 dans les industries diverses.

En 1946, 10,818 établissements du Québec ont fait rapport. Leur valeur totale de production s'élève à \$2,497,971,521, le nombre d'employés à 357,276, les salaires et gages à \$565,986,105, le coût des matières utilisées à \$1,297,009,099, tandis que la valeur ajoutée par la transformation est de \$1,125,991,848.

Le Québec, avec environ 31 p. 100 de la production totale du Canada, se classe deuxième parmi les provinces canadiennes. La production de pulpe et de papier occupe de nouveau le premier rang qui a été respectivement détenu en 1943 et 1944 par les produits chimiques divers et la réduction et l'affinage des métaux non ferreux. Cette industrie, en plus de former environ 11 p. 100 de la valeur brute de la fabrication dans le Québec en 1946, contribue pour environ 50 p. 100 de la production totale de pulpe et de papier dans le Dominion. La valeur des produits du tabac représente approximativement 89 p. 100, celle des filés et tissus de coton 71 p. 100, la confection pour femmes 68 p. 100, la soie 68 p. 100, les chaussures en cuir 65 p. 100, la confection pour hommes 59 p. 100, le matériel roulant de chemin de fer 54 p. 100, la confection des fourrures 48 p. 100 et la bonneterie et le tricot 41 p. 100, du total de ces produits pour le Canada. On voit par là que l'importance de cette province est due à l'ampleur de ses industries plutôt qu'à la variété des produits fabriqués. Pour ce qui est de la valeur brute de la production, les produits du bois et du papier occupent encore la première place avec une

manufacturing activity. From the standpoint of gross value of production the wood and paper products group with an output valued at \$527,311,296 again headed the list, displacing the iron and its products group which ranked first during the war years. Other major groups in order of their importance are: textiles and textile products \$491,637,370, vegetable products \$370,615,635, iron and its products \$330,375,759, animal products \$282,790,238, non-ferrous metal products \$213,677,920, non-metallic mineral products \$126,049,931, chemicals and allied products \$122,786,625, and miscellaneous industries \$32,726,747.

The pulp and paper industry with an output valued at \$265,989,953 in 1946 once again occupied the premier position. Women's factory clothing with an output of \$118,193,625 came second, followed by non-ferrous metal smelting and refining with \$106,254,910, men's factory clothing \$89,933,365, railway rolling-stock \$87,188,385, cotton yarn and cloth \$78,418,260, slaughtering and meat packing \$76,749,913, tobacco, cigars and cigarettes \$72,515,400, sawmills \$66,160,934, petroleum products \$63,510,289, boots and shoes, leather \$62,555,915, butter and cheese \$59,611,193, electrical apparatus and supplies \$59,193,595, etc.

The city of Montreal proper with a gross value of production of \$1,147,945,303 in 1946 was the most important manufacturing centre and accounted for 46 per cent of the entire output of the province. Other leading cities in the order of their importance are: Montreal East, Quebec, Three Rivers, Shawinigan Falls, Sherbrooke, Lachine, Drummondville, etc. Arvida is also an important manufacturing centre. The statistics for it do not, however, appear in Table 7 which gives the principal statistics of all cities and towns for which statistics can be shown without disclosing the operations of an individual establishment.

Les autres groupes sont comme suit: textiles et produits, \$491,637,370; produits végétaux, \$370,615,635; fer et ses produits, \$330,375,759; produits animaux, \$282,790,238; métaux non ferreux et leurs produits, \$213,677,920; métalloïdes et leurs produits, \$126,049,931; produits chimiques et leurs dérivés, \$122,786,625; et industries diverses, \$32,726,747.

L'industrie de la pulpe et du papier, avec une production de \$265,989,953 en 1946, occupe de nouveau le premier rang. La confection pour femmes, avec une valeur de \$118,193,625, se classe deuxième. Les autres principales industries sont: affinage et réduction des métaux non ferreux, \$106,254,910; confection pour hommes, \$89,933,365; matériel roulant de chemin de fer, \$87,188,385; filés et tissus de coton, \$78,418,260; abattoirs et salaisons, \$76,749,913; tabac, cigares et cigarettes, \$72,515,400; soieries, \$66,160,934; produits du pétrole, \$63,510,289; chaussures en cuir, \$62,555,915; beurre et fromage, \$59,611,193; appareils et fournitures électriques, \$59,193,595, etc.

La ville de Montréal, dont la production accuse une valeur brute de \$1,147,945,303 en 1946, se place bonne première avec environ 46 p. 100 du total général de la province. Les autres principales villes par ordre d'importance sont: Montréal-Est, Québec, Trois-Rivières, Shawinigan-Falls, Sherbrooke, Lachine, Drummondville, Granby, La Salle, etc. Arvida est aussi un centre manufacturier important. Ses statistiques ne paraissent cependant pas au tableau 7, qui ne donnent les principales statistiques des villes que là où la publication peut se faire sans divulguer les opérations particulières des établissements.
