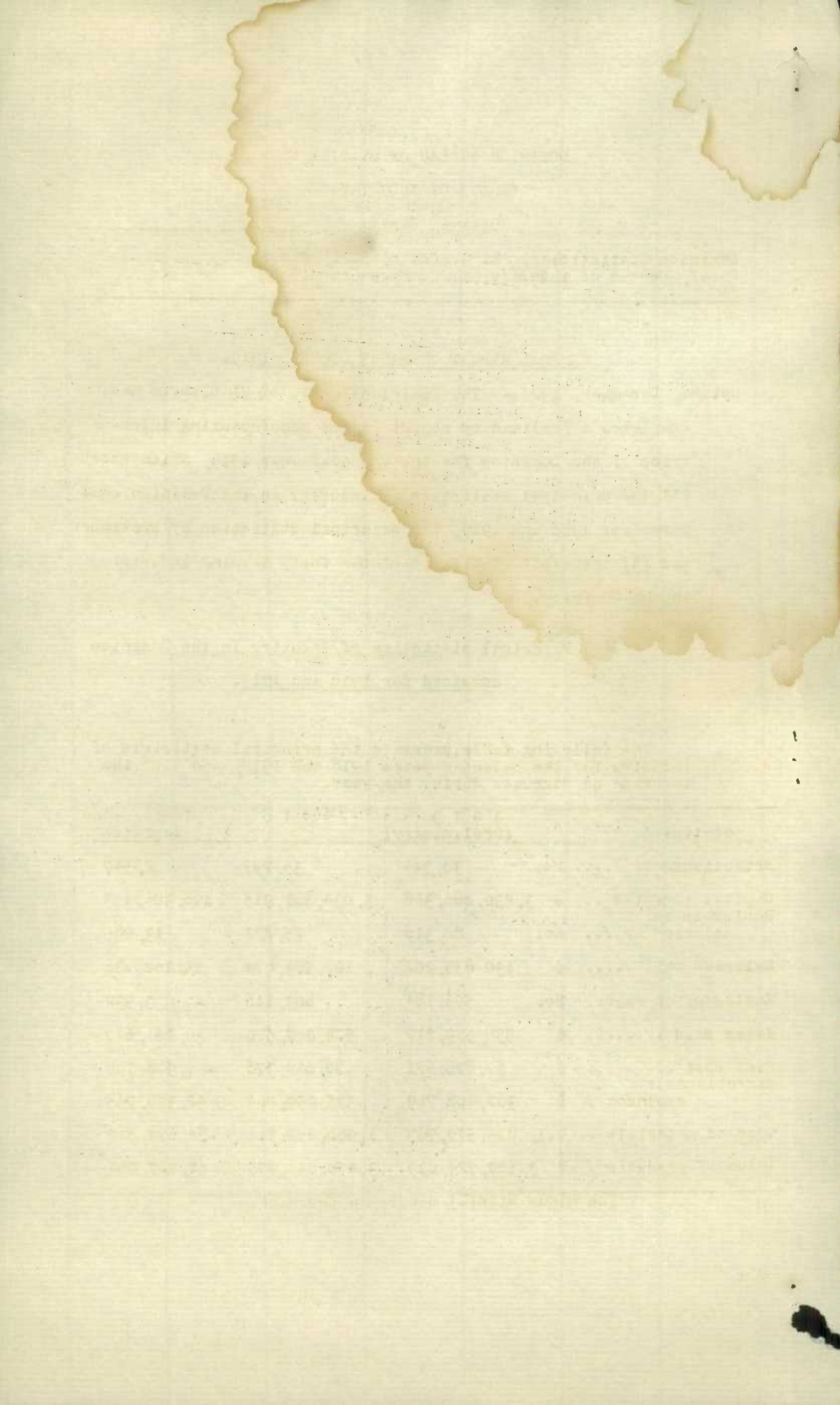
Ottawa, December, 1921.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics has completed a preliminary report on the manufacturing industries of the Dominion for the calendar year 1919, which shows (1) the principal statistics of industry in the Dominion compared for 1918 and 1919, (2) principal statistics by provinces and (3) principal statistics of the forty leading industries in the Dominion.

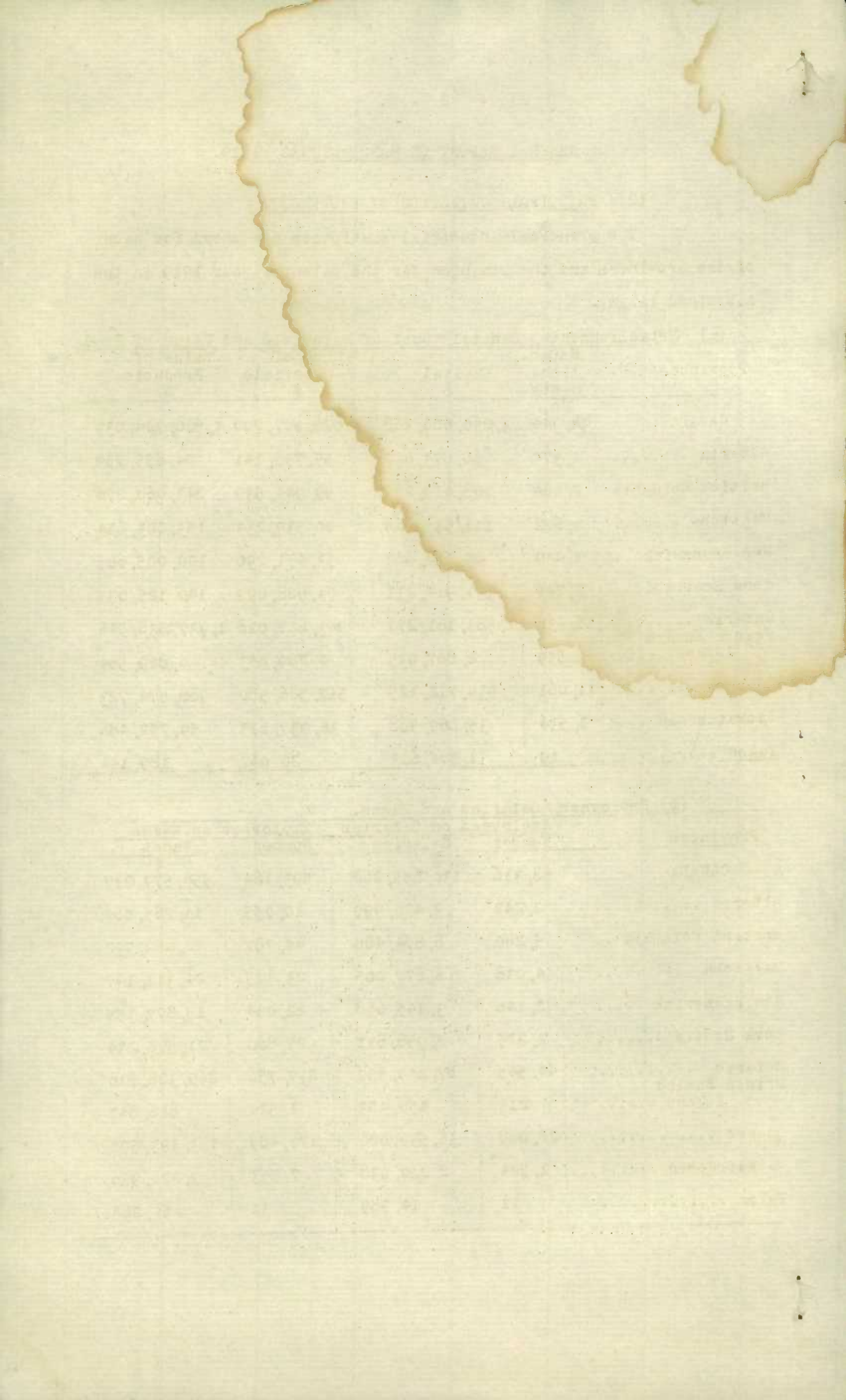

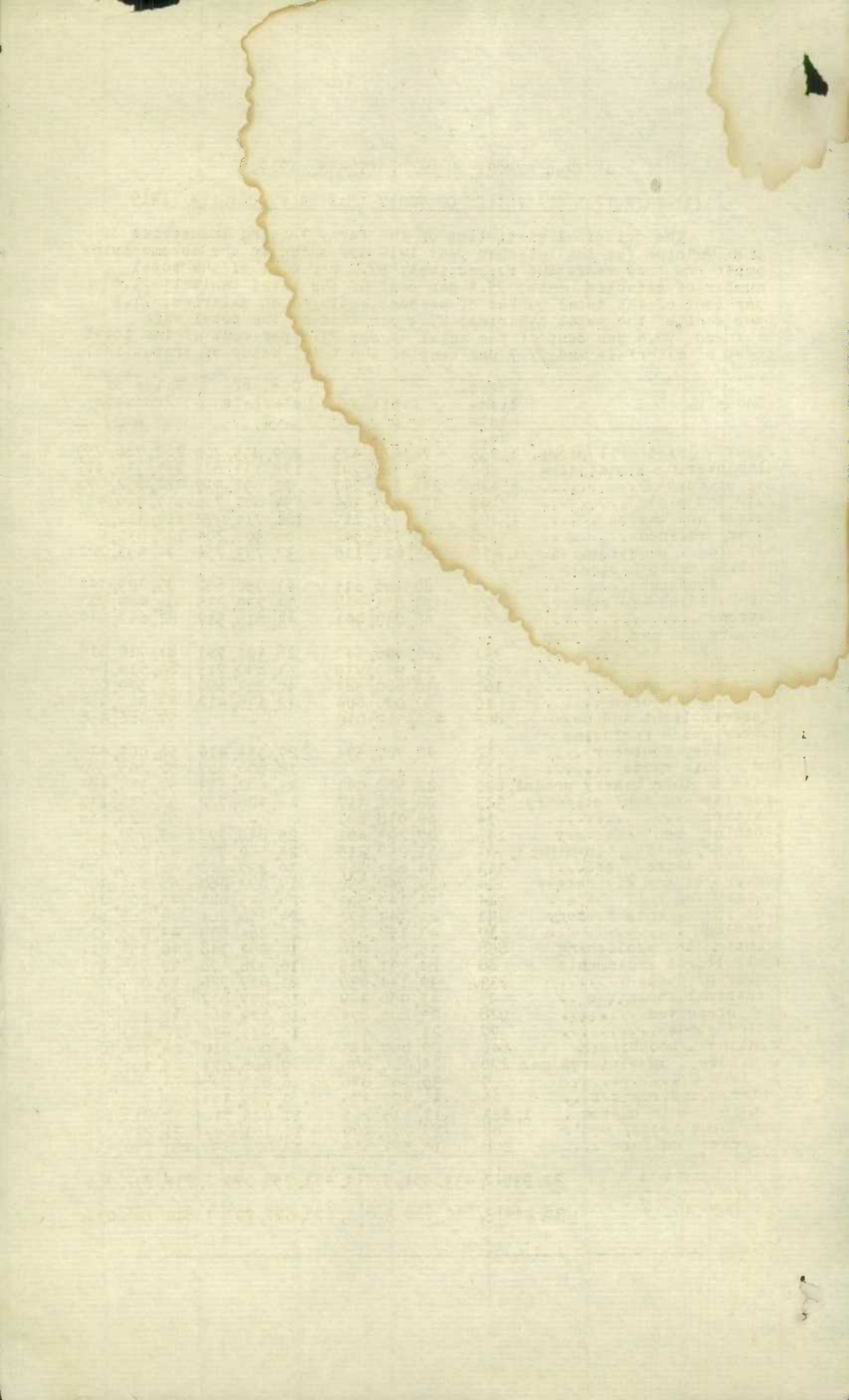

(3) PRINCIPAL STATISTICS OF FORTY LEADING INDUSTRIES, 1919

The principal statistics of the forty leading industries of the Dominion for the calendar year 1919 are shown in the accompanying table and they represent respectively 57.2 per cent of the total number of establishments; 75.3 per cent of the total capital; 73.4 per cent of the total number of persons employed on salaries; 71.3 per cent of the total salaries; 75.3 per cent of the total wage earners; 77.5 per cent of the total wages; 79.1 per cent of the total cost of materials and 77.7 per cent of the total value of production.
