Wettings of all types of hides and skins，with the exception of cowhide bell－ ies，showed decreases from the previous month．As compared with July 1950，there were decreases in all classes except horse hides，horse fronts and horse butts．

Stocks of raw cattle hides registered an increase of $l$ ．l $p, c$ c compared with the previous month and a decrease of 6.6 poc 。 compared with July 1950．
