STATISTICS ON HIDES, SKINS AND LEATHER

October, 1952

Wettings of cattle hides, calf and kip skins, horse fronts and horse butts showed increases over the previous month. As compared with October 1951, there were increases in all classes except goat and kid skins and horse fronts.

Stocks of raw cattle hides registered an increase of 9.1 p.c. compared with the previous month and an increase of 46.3 p.c. compared with October 1951.

Production of sole leather in October, at 1,326,347 lb. was 14.2 p.c. over the 1,161,519 lb. recorded for September; total deliveries at 1,345,408 lb. were 6.6 p.c. over the September figure of 1,261,572 lb. Cattle upper leather production was 4,425,994 sq. ft., 3.1 p.c. under the 4,567,311 sq. ft. in September; total deliveries at 4,290,214 sq. ft. were 7.0 p.c. under the 4,614,994 sq. ft. in September. Calf and kip upper leather production was 716,309 sq. ft., 3.0 p.c. under the 738,266 sq. ft. in September and total deliveries at 889,271 sq. ft. were 5.5 p.c. over the 842,808 sq. ft. in September.
