STATISTICS ON HIDES, SKINS AND LEATHER

## March, 1953

Wettings of all types of hides and skins, with the exception of cattle hides, horse butts and cowhide bellies showed decreases from the previous month. As compared with March 1952, there were decreases in all classes except cattle hides, sheep and lamb skins and horse hides.

Stocks of raw cattle hides registered an increase of 0.86 p.c. compared with the previous month and an increase of 28.9 p.c. compared with March 1952.

Production of sole leather in March, at $1,313,242 \mathrm{lb}$. was $15.6 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $1,555,828 \mathrm{lb}$. recorded for February; total deliveries at $1,453,548 \mathrm{lb}$. were 4.8 p.c. over the February figure of $1,387,402 \mathrm{lb}$. Cattle upper leather production was $4,900,072$ sq. ft. 3.3 p.c. over the $4,744,341 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. in February; total deliveries at $4,831,576 \mathrm{sq}$. ft . were $4.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. over the $4,612,840 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. in February. Calf and kip upper leather production was $740,691 \mathrm{sq} . \mathrm{ft}_{\mathrm{t}}, 5.9 \mathrm{p.c}$. under the 787,107 sq. ft. in February and total deliveries at 635,230 sq. ft. were 6.9 p.c. under the 681,967 sq. ft. in February.
