## STATISTICS ON HIDES, SKINS AND LEATHER

## April, 1953

Wettings of all types of hides and skins, with the exception of calf and kip skins and cowhide bellies showed decreases from the previous month. As compared with April 1952, there were increases in all classes except horse fronts, horse butts and cowhide bellies.

Stocks of raw cattle hides registered a decrease of 5.2 p.c. compared with the previous month and an increase of 18.2 p.c. compared with April 1952.

Production of sole leather in April, at 1,451,756 lb. was $10.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. over the 1,313,242 lb. recorded for March; total deliveries at 1,295,716 lb, were $10.8 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the March figure of $1,453,548 \mathrm{lb}$. Cattle upper leather production was $4,772,114$ sq. ft., $2.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $4,900,072 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. in March; total deliveries at $4,711,799 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. were $2.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $4,831,576 \mathrm{sq} . \mathrm{ft}$ 。in March. Calf and kip upper leather production was $493,735 \mathrm{sq}$. $\mathrm{ft} ., 33.3$ p.c. under the $740,691 \mathrm{sq}$. ft . in March and total deliveries at 502,024 sq. ft . were $21 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $635,230 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. in March
