## STATISTICS OF HIDES, SKINS AND LEATHER

Wettings in April of all types of hides and skins with the exception of sheep and lamb skins showed decreases from the previous month. As compared with April 1957, there were decreases in all classes.

Stocks of raw cattle hides registered a decrease of $0.3 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. compared with the previous month and a decrease of 20.5 pic. compared with April 1957.

Production of sole leather in April, at $950,197 \mathrm{lb}$. was $12.8 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. over the $842,637 \mathrm{lb}$. recorded for March; total deliveries at $1,024,190 \mathrm{lb}$. were 1.1 p . c. over the March figure of $1,012,587 \mathrm{lb}$. Cattle upper leather production was $5,082,198 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. $0.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $5,119,981 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. in March; total deliveries at $4,399,577 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. were $1.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. over the $4,828,177 \mathrm{sq}$. ft . in March. Calf and kip upper leather production was $875,277 \mathrm{sq}$. ft., $2.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. under the $897,557 \mathrm{sq}$. ft . in March and total deliveries at $786,021 \mathrm{sq}$. ft. were $2.9 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$. over the $763,-$ 908 sa. ft. in March.
