Stocks of Raw Hides and Skins in Canada November 30, and December 31, 1939 The Dominion Bureau of Statistics presents herewith the first of a new series of monthly reports based on information secured for the Wartime Prices and Trade Board showing stocks of raw hides and skins on hand in Canada. The figures contained in the table represent the total domestic and foreign stocks held at the end of the month by tanners, packing plants and dealers in hides and skins. Domestic hides and skins in transit to these firms are included. Foreign hides and skins in transit to Canadian firms are not included but are mentioned separately in a footnote to the table. Stocks of raw cattle hides on hand at the end of December, 1939, amounted to 703,956 hides compared with 661,310 hides at the end of the preceding month. There were 593,647 calf and kip skins on hand on December 31, compared with 676,836 on November 30. Stocks of sheep and lamb skins amounted to 77,726 dozen at the end of December; goat and kid skins numbered 74,969 units and horse hides, 28,426. Further details are shown in the table.
