STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

September, 1941

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics presents herewith one of a series of monthly reports based on information secured for the Wartime Prices and Trade Board showing stocks of raw hides and skins on hand in Canada. The figures contained in the table represent the total domestic and foreign stocks held at the end of the month by tanners, packing plants and dealers in hides and skins. Figures in the tables include all domestic stocks in transit to Canadian firms and also any sheep and lamb skins, goat and kid skins of foreign origin which may be in transit. The figures do not include foreign cattle hides, calf or kip skins in transit to Canadian firms but such items are mentioned in a footnote to the table.

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 489,297 at the end of September, 1941, compared with 432,029 at the end of August, 1941, and 589,714 at the end of September, 1940. Total stocks on hand at the end of September, 1941, were made up of 393,402 hides of domestic origin and 95,895 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 295,403 packer or small packer and 97,999 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand increased from 580,776 at the end of August to 613,396 at the end of September, 1941. Stocks of other types at the end of September, 1941, included 64,580 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 95,382 goat and kid skins, and 17,144 horse hides.

Note: In addition to the figures reported above, raw stocks of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners included 11,451 cattle hides at the end of September, 1940, 27,190 at the end of August, 1941, and 17,687 at the end of September, 1941. At the end of September, 1941, no calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners were reported.
