STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

FEBRUARA, 1943

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics presents herewith one of a series of monthly reports based on information secured for the Wartime Prices and Trade Board showing stocks of raw hides and skins on hand in Ganada. The figures contained in the table represent the total domestic and foreign stocks held at the end of the month by tanners, packing plants and dealers in hides and skins. Figures in the tables include all domestic stocks in transit to Ganadian firms and also any sheep and lamb skins, goat and kid skins of foreign origin which may be in transit. The figures do not include foreign cattle hides, calf ar kip skins in transit to Ganadian firms but such items are mentioned in a footnote to the table.

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 424,595 at the end of February, 1943, compared with 438,363 at the end of January, 1943 and 586,675 at the end of February, 1942. Total stocks on hand at the end of February, 1943, were made up of 372,484 hides of domestic origin and hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 227,190 packer or small packer and 145,294 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand decreased from 766,143 at the end of January, 1943 to 669,027 at the end of February, 1943. Stocks of other types at the end of February, 1943, included 90,120 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 40,392 goat and kid skins, and 26,963 horse hides.

Note: In addition to the figures reported above, raw stocks of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners included 12,743 cattle hides at the end of February, 1942, 33,900 at the end of January, 1943 and 36,550 at the end of February, 1943. At the end of February, 1943 no calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners we reported.
