STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

June, 1943

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 455,737 at the end of June, 1943, compared with 466,782 at the end of May, 1943 and 444,642 at the end of June, 1942. Total stocks on hand at the end of June, 1943, were made up of 356,862 hides of domestic origin and 98,875 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 241,662 packer or small packer and 115,200 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand decreased from 648,824 at the end of May, 1943, to 641,019 at the end of June, 1943. Stocks of other types at the end of June, 1943 included 76,554 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 1,932 goat and kid skins and 26,715 horse hides.

Note: In addition to the figures reported above, raw stocks of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners included 21,960 cattle hides at the end of June, 1942, 37,500 at the end of May, 1943, and 45,431 at the end of June, 1943. Calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners were reported at 2,288 at the end of June, 1942, whereas 1,647 were reported at the end of May, 1943 and none at the end of June, 1943.

1981-82

Table 1 shows the total value of goods and services produced in the manufacturing, construction and service sectors of the economy. The total value of goods and services produced in the manufacturing sector was \$14,960 million in 1981-82, an increase of 3.5% over 1980-81. The total value of goods and services produced in the construction sector was \$2,840 million in 1981-82, an increase of 1.5% over 1980-81. The total value of goods and services produced in the service sector was \$10,200 million in 1981-82, an increase of 2.0% over 1980-81.

Table 2 shows the total value of goods and services produced in the manufacturing, construction and service sectors of the economy. The total value of goods and services produced in the manufacturing sector was \$14,960 million in 1981-82, an increase of 3.5% over 1980-81. The total value of goods and services produced in the construction sector was \$2,840 million in 1981-82, an increase of 1.5% over 1980-81. The total value of goods and services produced in the service sector was \$10,200 million in 1981-82, an increase of 2.0% over 1980-81.
