## STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

November, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 513,110 at the end of November, 1944 compared with 465,493 at the end of October, 1944 and 443,556 at the end of November, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of November, 1944, were made up of 486,210 hides of domestic origin and 26,900 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 366 485 packer or small packer and 119,725 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand decreased from 356,420 at the end of October 1944 to 354,527 at the end of November, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of November, 1944 included 108,632 dozen sheep and lamb skins 136 287 goat and kid skins and 21,064 horse hides.

There were no calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners at the end of November: 1945, or at the end of October, 1944. whereas 65,450 were reported at the end of November, 1944.
