STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

December, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Ganada amounted to 497,361 at the end of December, 1944 compared with 523,110 at the end of November, 1944 and 482,903 at the end of December, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of December, 1944, were made up of 474,961 hides of domestic origin and 22,400 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 329,391 packer or small packer and 145,570 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand increased from 352,639 at the end of November, 1944 to 456,258 at the end of December, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of December, 1944, included 116,454 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 352,803 goat and kid skins and 24,735 horse hides.
