TOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA March, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 446, 346 at the end of March, 1944, compared with 467,708 at the end of February, 1944, and 449,184 at the end of March, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of March, 1944, were made up 401,881 hides of domestic origin and 44,465 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 278,687 packer or small packer and 123,194 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand increased from 396,431 at the end of February. 1944, to 399,947 at the end of March 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of March 1944. included 86,056 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 135,275 goat and kid skins and 23.094 horse hides.

In addition to the figures reported above, raw stocks of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners were reported at 38,573 cattle hides at the end of March, 1943, 12,088 at the end of February, 1944, and 5,000 at the end of March, 1944. Calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners were reported at 14,500 at the end of March, 1943 whereas, none were reported at the end of February, 1944, or at the end of March, 1944.
