STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA April, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 466,385 at the end of April, 1944, compared with 446,734 at the end of March, 1944, and 465,525 at the end of April, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of April, 1944, were made up of 422,459 hides of domestic origin and 43,926 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 297,101 packer or small packer and 125.358 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand increased from 399,281 at the end of March, 1944 to 419,311 at the end of April, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of April, 1944, included 80,830 dozen sheep and lamb skins 72,316 goat and kid skins and 25,906 horse hides.
