STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA June, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 447.620 at the end of June, 1944, compared with 432,551 at the end of May, 1944, and 455.737 at the end of June, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of June, 1944, were made up of 401,234 hides of domestic origin and 46,386 hides of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 281,118 packer or small packer and 120,116 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand increased from 461,627 at the end of May, 1944, to 497,397 at the end of June, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of June, 1944, included 85,220 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 127,666 goat and kid skins and 19,844 horse hides.
