STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA July, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 428,460 at the end of July, 1944 compared with 436,141 at the end of June, 1944 and 473,199 at the end of July, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of July, 1944, were made up of 400,659 hides of domestic origin and 27,801 of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 286,213 packer or small packer and 114,446 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand decreased from 497,397 at the end of June, 1944 to 472,196 at the end of July, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of July, 1944, included 87,738 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 89,671 goat and kid skins and 14,713 horse hides.
