STOCKS OF RAW HIDES AND SKINS IN CANADA

September, 1944

Stocks of raw cattle hides held by tanners, packers and dealers in Canada amounted to 441,780 at the end of September, 1944 compared with 425,895 at the end of August, 1944 and 487,285 at the end of September, 1943. Total stocks on hand at the end of September, 1944, were made up of 403,663 hides of domestic origin and 38,117 of foreign origin. The domestic stock included 299,877 packer or small packer and 103,786 country hides.

Calf and kip skins on hand decreased from 426,973 at the end of August, 1944 to 389,620 at the end of September, 1944. Stocks of other types at the end of September, 1944, included 114,575 dozen sheep and lamb skins, 75,109 goat and kid skins and 11,491 horse hides.

There were no calf skins of foreign origin in transit to Canadian tanners at the end of September, 1943, August, 1944 or September, 1944.
