The report of the boot and shoo production of Canada for the month of November is based on the retuens of 167 façories ont of a tctal of 171 factories in speration in that month. Three factories in Quebec and 1 in Ontario failed to make returns. A total of $1,661,016$ pairs of leather and felt footwear is shown as the production for the month of November, a decrease from the preceding month of 83.752 pairs, or 5 p.c. The leather footwear made totalled 1,525,739 pairs, comprising footwear for men, 443,248 pairs; for boys and youthe, 149,556 pairs; for women, 630,309 pairs; for misses and children, 200,681 pairs, and for babies and infants 101,945 pairs. The two last classifications show increases in production, while the other classifications show decreases. In the classification of leather footwear acorcing to process of manufacture, "welts", "McKays and all imitation welts", "turns", and "pegged, screw or wire fastened", show "ecreases in quantity of output, while the classification of "stitchdowns" shows ai increase. The number of peirs of felt footmear made was 135,277, a Gecrease from the precoding month if 8,515 pairs. The cumulative production of leather and felt footmar (exclusive of larrigans and shoepacks, and Indien slippers and moccasins) for the 11 months Jamary to November. 1926, was $17.082,000$ pairs, which exceeds the total production for 1925 (excludine the same items as $i_{61} 926$ ) by 530,201 pairs.
