## KOMILLY BEPUTIT ON THE BOCI AND BHOE PRODUCTION OF CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1926

The Statistios of the present bullotin are hased on retames receivad Crom 152 boot and choe factories, out of a total of 157 factories in operation In Canada. For Nova Scotia, 2 returns were received out of a total of 3 ; for quebec, 85 out of a total of 87 ; for Ontario, 56 out of a total of 57 ; and for British Columbia, $\&$ out of a total of 5 . Complete returns were received for the five establishmento in New brunswick. The production in the year 1924 of the 162 factories whose returns are included in the present bulletin, represents 99.6 per cent of the total production of coot and shoe factorios in operation In Canada in 1924. The total number of pairs of leather and felt footwear made during the month of February, 1926, was 1. 434.503 , comprising $1,372,212$ pairs of Doots and shoes with ieather or fabric uppers, and 62,291 pairs of felt fooswear of all kindz and cloth slippers for house wear. These totals are exolusive of larrieans and shoepacks and Indian moccasins and slippers. The production for the month of January, based on the returns of 141 factories out of a total of 159 factories in operation, comprised $1,149,198$ pairs of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers and 49,463 pairs of felt footwear of all
