The statistics of the present bulletin are based on returns received from 164 boot and shoe factories out of a total of 166 factories in operation in Canada during the month of April. The distribution of the factories, by provinces, it as follows- Nova Scotia, 3; New Brunswick, 5; Quebec, 94; Ontario, 57; and British Columbia, 5. One factory in Quebec and one in ontario failed to make return. The total number of pairs of footwear made during the month of April was $1,527,533$, compared with $1,762,446$ for the preceding month, a decrease of 234,913 pairs or 13 per cent. The total for April comprised $1,426,578$ pairs of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers and 100,955 pairs of felt footwear and cloth slippers for house wear. Production under the latter classification shows an increase. Detailed statistics of production for the month of April are given below.
