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MONMHY REPORT OF TFE HOCT AND SHOE PROIUCTION OF CAIADA<br>SEPTENBER, 2026.

The statistice of the present report are based on the returne of 167 factcries out of a total of 170 factories in operation in Cunada during the month of September. Two factories in Queboc and cne in Ontario falled to make return. The quantities of leather and felt footreat made during the month totalled $1,644,6-4$ pairs, an increase over the preceding month of 113.457 pairs or $\vec{i}$ per cent. The quantity of bcots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers increased by 127,415 pairs, or a per cent, while the quantity of felt footprear of all kinds and cloth slinners for house wear shows a decrease of 12,958 nairs, or 13 ner cent. The classification of boots and st.ocs with leather or fabric uppers according to kinds, viz: men's; bay $6^{\prime}$ and youths'; memen's; misses' and children's; and babies' and infants', shoms increasee for all of the items. The classification according to prccess shows increases for welts, Nickaws and all imitation welts, and peged, ecrem or wire fastened, while turns and stitchdowns show decreased production. The following table gives the total production of footwear for each of the months Jamary to September:
