HONIHLY REFORT ON THE BOOT AND SHOE PRODUCTION OF CANADA, MAY, 1927.

The statistics of the present report are based on the returns of 177 factories out of a total of 179 factories in pperation in Canada during the month. One factory in quebec and one in Ontario failed to make return. The factories in operation during the month are located by provinces as follows: Nova Scutia, 3 ; New Brunswick, 5; Quebec, 106; Ontario, 59; and British Columbia, 6.

The total quantity of footwear with leatner or fabric uppers made during the month was $1,480,003$ pairs, compared with a total of $1,450,672$ pairs for the preceding month and with a total of $1,352,720$ paids for the month of May, 1926. The production of shoepacks and larrigans totalled 20,592 nairs; of footwear with felt uppers, 58,017 pairs; and of boudoir and Indian slippers, 45,274 pairs, bringing the total production of footwear for the month of May, 1927, up to $1,603,886$ pairs, an increase over the preceding month of 37,136 pairs, or 2 per cent. An increase of 9 per cent is show in the output of shoes for women, of 2 per cent in the output for boys and youths, of 3 por cent for misses and childrens, and of 1 per cent for babies and infants. The production of men's shoes was less than in the preceding month, the decrease amounting to 8 per cent. Comparison of the production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers in May, 1927, with the production for the corresponding month of 1926 shows increases for the classifications of mon's, women's and misses and children's. The percontages of increase for these items are as follows: men's, 8 per cent; women's, 12 per cent; and misses' and children's, 19 per cent. The production of boots and shoes classified as boys' and youths' and babies' and infants', show decreases of 5 and 1 pur cent respectively. Comparison with the production for the month of May, 1926, can bo made only for footwear with leather or fabric uppors, as the monthly census of 1926 did not includo an inquiry relating to the production of shoonacks, larrigans and moccasins.

The cumulative production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers for the five months enced May 31,1927 was $7,372,268$ pairs, an average of $1,474,453$ pairs per month, compared with a total of $6,987,373$ nairs and an average of $1,397,475$ pairs per month for the corresponding period of 1926.
